Introduction

Tonight we're going to pick up where we left off last week. We began to see how the LORD raised up GIDEON to deliver the CHILDREN OF ISRAEL from yet another OPPRESSION brought on by their sin!

We saw the same CYCLE as before taking place:

- I. WE SAW ISRAEL'S SIN! (Judges 6:1a)
- II. WE SAW ISRAEL'S SUFFERING! (Judges 6:1b-6a)
- III. WE SAW ISRAEL'S SUPPLICATION! (Judges 6:6b)
- IV. WE SAW ISRAEL'S SALVATION!

THE JUDGE NAMED GIDEON

We were seeing how The LORD Raised Up And Called A Man By The Name Of GIDEON To Lead HIS People In Battle Against The MIDIANITES.

- I. WHEN THE ANGEL OF THE LORD FIRST CAME TO GIDEON HE WAS HIDING HIS WHEAT THRESHING ACTIVITY FROM THE MIDIANITES! (Judges 6:11-12a)
- *II.* WE SAW THAT, IN SPITE OF HIS HIDING AND IN SPITE OF HIS DOUBTS ABOUT HIMSELF, THE LORD WAS WITH HIM AND CALLED HIM TO DELIVER ISRAEL! (Judges 6:12b-16)
- *III. WE SAW THAT AT FIRST GIDEON'S FAITH WAS WEAK!* (Judges 6:14-24)
 - A. GIDEON'S Weak Faith Is Shown In His Initial FOCUS On His Own LIMITATIONS And WEAKNESSES Rather Than On The LORD! (Vs 14-15)
 - B. The Call Of The LORD On His Life Here Trumped His Weak Faith! (Vs 14b, 16)
 - C. His Weak Faith Was Seen In His Interaction With The Angel Of The LORD. (Vs 17-24)
- *IV.* WE SAW GIDEON'S FIRST ASSIGNMENT FROM THE LORD. (Judges 6:25-26)

HE instructed GIDEON to:

- 1) Tear down the altar of BAAL that his father had,
- 2) To cut down the grove beside it, and
- 3) To build an altar to the LORD GOD and sacrifice his father's seven year old bull using the wood he got from cutting down the grove.
- V. WE SAW GIDEON OBEYED THE LORD, BUT HE DID SO AT NIGHT! (Vs 27)
- VI. WE SAW THE UPROAR BY THE MEN IN THE CITY FOR WHAT HAD BEEN DONE BY GIDEON! (Vs 28-30)
- VII. WE SAW THAT GIDEON'S FATHER CAME TO HIS DEFENSE! (Vs 31)

GIDEON was then given another name by his father—"Jerubbaal", which means "let Baal plead." (Vs 32)

BEFORE WE MOVE ON FROM THIS LET'S NOTE THREE THINGS:

1. The SPIRITUAL Must Come Before The PHYSICAL! *Matthew 6:33– "But seek ye first the Kingdom of God…"* Again, ISRAEL'S greatest problem was a SPIRITUAL problem! Though their primary concern was their SUFFERING, the LORD'S primary concern was their SIN OF IDOLATRY!

They wanted **HELP** but not **HOLINESS**! They wanted **REVENGE** but not **RIGHTEOUSNESS**! They wanted **VICTORY** but not **VIRTUE**!

But, the LORD does not DELIVER people IN THEIR SINS! HE DELIVERS them FROM THEIR SINS!

Even today we find that people want the **LORD** to solve their **EARTHLY PROBLEMS**, but they don't want to deal with their **SPIRITUAL PROBLEMS** first!

The priority of our lives should **be SPIRITUAL MATTERS FIRST** and earthly concerns second!

The SPIRITUAL Must Come Before The PHYSICAL!

2. The PRIVATE Must Come Before The PUBLIC! Before GIDEON could take the war to the country, he had to FIGHT THE WAR AT HOME! Before he could reform a nation, he first had to REFORM HIS HOME!

REVIVAL of a nation comes from **PERSONAL REVIVAL** first...then to the family....then to the Church... and then to a nation!

3. The SMALL Must Come Before The GREAT! Before GIDEON could be trusted to lead an army, he had to prove himself in his household and hometown!

Luke 16:10– "*He that is faithful in that which is least is faithful also in much: and he that is unjust in the least is unjust also in much.*"

- VIII. WE SEE GIDEON AND THE PEOPLE OF ISRAEL GATHERED TO FIGHT THE MIDIANITES. Judges 6:33-40; 7:1-2
 - A. We See That The MIDIANITE Army Along With The AMALEKITES And Some Others From The East Were Ready To Move Against ISRAEL Again! (6:33)
 - 1. There was a great host of men and equipment. (7:12)
 - 2. There were 135,000 fighting men. (8:10)
 - B. Under The SPIRIT OF THE LORD's Direction, GIDEON Gathered An Army. (6:34-35)
 - C. Then We See Another Weak Display Of FAITH From GIDEON. (6:36-40)
 - D. ISRAEL'S Army Gathered To Oppose MIDIAN. (7:1-2)

- 1. Understand that this army of 32,000 were untried, untrained, and ill equipped men.
- Consider GIDEON'S reaction to the people following him. He might have been overwhelmed that the people listened and that the LORD had chosen him. But, he also might have looked on the 32,000 as not being enough to do the task.
- 3. The LORD'S analysis of the 32,000 was that there were too many for HIM to bless. 32,000 vs 135,000 (4.22 to 1 odds)
- 4. The LORD'S reason was ISRAEL'S PRIDE!
- 5. Consider MAN'S PRIDE and the LORD'S WAYS! 1 Corinthians 1:27-31–"But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty; And base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, [yea], and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are: That no flesh should glory in his presence. But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption: That, according as it is written, He that glorieth, let him glory in the Lord."

IX. GIDEON AND THE PEOPLE WERE PREPARED BY THE LORD. (Judges 7:3-14)

- A. The First Test Was Given And 22,000 Were Eliminated. (7:3)
 - Those who were FEARFUL and AFRAID were those who didn't believe they could win. They did not understand the greatness of the LORD being on their side in the fight!

2. Consider *Exodus 14:13* when all of **ISRAEL** had their backs to the **RED SEA** and the **EGYPTIAN** army was in pursuit.

"And Moses said unto the people, Fear ye not, stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD, which he will shew to you today: for the Egyptians whom ye have seen today, ye shall see them again no more for ever."

Later in **ISRAEL'S** future the **LORD**, through the **PROPHET ISAIAH** had to remind them again ! *Isaiah 41:10–"Fear thou not; for I [am] with thee: be not dismayed; for I [am] thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness."*

- After this first culling of GIDEON'S army, he had 10,000 men left (13.5 to 1 odds). (7:4)
 The LORD'S analysis was that there were still too many.
- **B.** A Second Test Was Given To Whittle The Number Down. They were to go down to the water. (7:4-7)
 - 1. None of these were afraid.
 - 2. These were tested by drinking water.
 - a. Those who fell on their knees were those who might take their eyes off the enemy.
 - b. Those who lapped the water out of their hand were those who were fully alert.
 - 3. So, GIDEON had 300 men left. (450 to 1 odds)
 - a. Consider the decrease.
 - b. Consider the caliber of soldiers.
 - 4. The LORD would save ISRAEL by the 300. (7:7)

The LORD uses men of HIS own choosing!

- 5. Everybody else was sent home! (7:8)
- C. GIDEON Was Assured. (7:9-15)

X. GIDEON AND THE 300 WENT TO WAR. (Judges 7:16-21)

- A. We See Their Strategy! (7:16-18)
- B. They Worked This Strategy! (7:19-20)
- C. Every Man Stood In His Place! (7:21) After blowing their trumpets and breaking their pitchers they let the LORD do what they could not do!
- XI. THE LORD SET EVERY MAN'S SWORD AGAINST HIS FELLOW TO ACCOMPLISH THE VICTORY FOR ISRAEL! (7:22-25)

Conclusion

That's our **BIBLE STUDY** for this evening. **LORD** willing, we will come back and look at *chapter 8* where we see a few problems **GIDEON** encountered in his **PURSUIT** of the kings of **MIDIAN**!

One of the problems came from their brethren...the **EPHRAIMITES**, whom he had to appease. Other problems came from the men in **SUCCOTH** and **PENUEL** who refused to give him and his army bread in their pursuit.

And we'll see a few other things as we wrap up the story of **GIDEON**.
