THE PARTS OF THE ARMOR

REVIEW

- The goal of the Christian is to "stand" = to persevere in your faith.
- The enemy of the Christian is powerful.
 - PrincePowerful
 - Rulers of darkness
 - Hosts of spiritual wickedness

REVIEW

- Our METHOD is to take up the provided armor.
- Our MOTIVE is that we may be able to stand (only God's armor will work); and to stand (God's armor will work, if used).
- Our DOCTRINE: These pieces of armor have reference to Christ.
 - Perseverance rests on believing in Christ's sufficiency
 - Perseverance rests on being assured of Christ's work

Wrong Practices Regarding God's Armor

- We take them as "personally empowering".
- We take them subjectively, not objectively.
- We forget that the goal of Satan's warfare is our "giving up" the faith in despair; so that the goal of the Christian is to maintain faith in Christ.

1. (vs. 14a) — The Belt of Truth



- Truth upholds
 everything else.
 Doctrine is the
 foundation of all ability
 to persevere.
- Therefore, we should not be surprised when those with poor (or no) doctrine abandon a false faith.
- Doctrinal truth is made to be applied.

2. (vs. 14b) — The Breastplate of Righteousness



- Whose righteousness?
- Based on Christ's deity; sinless life; substitutionary death; ascension and intercession.
- Doctrine of justification clarified.
- When we sin...

3. (vs. 15) — The Shoes of the Gospel of Peace



- Our status with God has changed from being an enemy to being at peace with God. (see Romans 5:10; Colossians 1:21)
- Our "grip" as a Christian is founded on our ability to stand in our new relationship to God.

4. (vs. 16) — The Shield of Faith



- "The Door"
- Remember: not subjective
- This is an active faith a choice regularly to
 remind yourself of
 what Christ has done
 for you.
- Q: What means do we use?

5. (vs. 17a) — The Helmet of Salvation



- "Salvation" in the NT
- 1Thess. 5:8; 1Peter 1:3-5
- How much does the hope of heaven mean to us?

6. (vs. 17b) — The Sword of the Spirit



- Emphasis on "the word of God."
- "Lies of the world"
- A beginner using a sword?

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1. THE BELT OF TRUTH

- Truth holds up everything else
- "Should we be surprised when...?"
- Truth without application?

2. THE BREASTPLATE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS

- Our primary protection against Satan's attack
 - Q: What do we mean by "righteousness"?

• Q: What doctrines / truths supports this idea?

• Q: What, then, is our tendency when we sin?

3. "HAVING <u>SHOD</u> YOUR FEET WITH THE PREPARATION OF THE GOSPEL OF PEACE"

- "Shod"?-
 - Middle English, past participle of "shoe"
 - Acts 12:8 "... tie on your sandals...."
 - · Slip-shod? Dry-shod?

3. "HAVING SHOD YOUR FEET WITH THE PREPARATION OF THE GOSPEL OF PEACE"

- Normal Roman soldier footwear
- "Preparation" = readiness; or stability (in the sense of a well-prepared base or foundation).

3. "HAVING SHOD YOUR FEET WITH THE PREPARATION OF THE GOSPEL OF PEACE"

- SCRIPTURES (related to God/gospel): Acts
 10:36; Romans 5:1; Romans 10:15; Romans
 15:13; Colossians 1:20
- Q: Are you at peace with God? Is God at peace with you? Do we remember this when tempted to quit?
