The True Work of God (John 6: 26-29)

- Jesus feeds the 5000 with two small fish and five barley loaves.
- People see the sign: "this truly is the prophet who is to come into the world."
- They wanted to take Jesus and make Him king by force (6:15)

I. People Express Their Need (6: 25)

- A. Living in a sinful, fallen world people are needy.
- B. Why they were seeking Jesus.

"You seek me because of the loaves, not because you saw the sign" (v.26)

II. Jesus Shows Them Their True Need (6:27)

- A. What not to labor for: "Do not labor for food that perishes (27a)
- B. What to labor for: "for food which endures to everlasting life" (27b)
- C. The gift of eternal life: "which the Son of Man will give you." (27c)
- D. Jesus authority: "because God the Father has set His seal on Him" (27d)

III. The Works of God (6:29)

- A. "This is the work of God" (v.29a)
- B. "That you believe in Him whom He sent" (v.29b)
