The True Work of God (John 6: 26-29)

- Jesus feeds the 5000 with two small fish and five barley loaves.
- People see the sign: *“this truly is the prophet who is to come into the world.”*
- They wanted to take Jesus and make Him king by force (6:15)

I. People Express Their Need (6: 25)

A. Living in a sinful, fallen world – people are needy.

B. Why they were seeking Jesus.

“You seek me because of the loaves, not because you saw the sign” (v.26)

II. Jesus Shows Them Their True Need (6:27)

A. What not to labor for: *“Do not labor for food that perishes* (27a)

B. What to labor for: *“for food which endures to everlasting life”* (27b)

C. The gift of eternal life: *“which the Son of Man will give you.”* (27c)

D. Jesus authority: *“because God the Father has set His seal on Him”* (27d)

III. The Works of God (6:29)

A. *“This is the work of God”* (v.29a)

B. *“That you believe in Him whom He sent”* (v.29b)
