INTRODUCTION

- 1. Phil 4:4-5 We are called to cultivate a disposition of gentle joy & then demonstrate gentle joy.
- **2.** We need to rehearse the gospel in these matters repentance, forgiveness & faith in Christ that perseveres in pursuit of holiness.

1st: The Demand to Demonstrate Forbearance

- 1. <u>v5</u> is not optional: a command [as v4 *rejoice*]. The command *let be known* a passive imperative: "let this be done to & thru you" by the HS.
 - i. <u>Gal 5:22-23</u> We actively demonstrate this fruit by being acted upon by HS. Diligently yielding to the HS. Be aggressively passive!
 - ii. Rm 12:1-2 2 passive imperatives: do not be acted on by world, but by HS
- 2. <u>let gentle spirit be known</u>. succeed in communicating. <u>Mt 5:14-16</u> men are to see our active passivity by which God uses us.
- **3.** To whom are we to be forbearing? *All men.* 2C 3:2; Rm 12:17,18; 1T 2:1-4; 1T 4:10; Tit 2:11; Tit 3:2.
- 4. Men are to look at us & see the life & power of Jesus.

Applic #1: Gently Communicate Your Joy in the Lord to Others

- 1. We are communicating creatures: body & verbal language reveals the condition of our hearts.
- 2. Ask those who love you what you communicate to them. If you receive "oil of rebuke", don't let your head refuse it [Ps 141:5]. Thank Christ for gospel love from those who want you to grow in holiness & fruitful service Phil 4:4-5
