Moses

- 1) King issued a decree to kill infant males at birth (Ex 1:22) 2:16)
- 2) He was hidden in Egypt from the evil king (Ex 2:2)
- 3) Long period of silence from childhood to adulthood
- 4) Married a Gentile (Num 12:1)
- 5) Became the prince of Egypt (Ex 2:10)
- 6) Was at the same time a slave (Hebrew) and royalty
- 7) Left his royal position to set His people free were slaves (Ex 2:11)
- 8) Left Egypt prior to His ministry (Ex 2:15)
- 9) Saved women at a well (Ex 2:15-22)-one became his bride
- 10) 40 years in the wilderness before his ministry (Acts 7:29-30)
- 11) Moses was a shepherd (Ex 3:1)
- 12) Moses was a prophet (Deut 18:15)
- 13) Performed miracles (Water to blood- Ex 7:14-25) Water from a rock (Ex 17, Numb 20)
- 14) His mission was to redeem Israel from slavery (Ex 3)
- 15) The symbol for Pharaoh's royalty/authority-serpent
- 16) Moses would have victory over Pharaoh (serpent)
- 17) His people were enslaved 400 years before he rescue came to rescue (Gen 15:13)(Acts 7:6)

Jesus

- 1) Herod decreed all male children 2 and under be killed (Mt 2:16)
- 2) Taken to Egypt to flee an evil king (Mt 2:13-15)
- 3) Long period of silence from childhood to adulthood (Luke 2:41-52)- 12 years old to 30 y/o is unknown
- 4) His bride is made up of Jew/Gentile (Eph 3:1-11)(Rom 16:25-26)(Rom 9:24)
- 5) He is the Prince of Peace (Is 9:6)
- 6) In the incarnation He took on the form of a servant, but is Lord who has all authority, every knee will bow(Phil 2:5-11)
- 7) Left the glory of heaven and took on the form of a bondservant(Phil 2:5-11) to set His people who were slaves to sin and the devil free (Rom 6:6)(John 8:36)(2 Tim 2:26)
- 8) Was called out of Egypt prior to His ministry (Matt 2:15)
- 9) Saved a woman at a well(John 4)-Became the bride of Christ
- 10) Jesus fasted and was tempted 40 days in the wilderness prior to His ministry (Matt 4:1-2)
- 11) Jesus is the good shepherd (John 10:11)
- 12) Christ is The Prophet Moses spoke about in Deut 18:15 (Acts 3:22-23)
- 13) Performed miracles (water to wine-John 2), Is the spiritual Rock (1 Cor 10:1-4)
- 14) His mission was to set spiritual Israel free (John 8:36) (Gal 5:1)(2 Tim 2:24-26)(Romans 6).
- 15) Satan is referred to as a serpent (Gen 3:14-15) (Rev 12:9) (Rev 20:2)
- 16) Victory over the serpent on the cross (Col 2:13-15)
- 17) ~400 years passed between the OT and Christ coming to His people and set them free.

| 24) Face shined from the presence of God (Ex 34:29-35) | 24) Face shined with His glory (Matthew 17:2)(Rev 1:12-18) |
| 25) Initiated the first Passover (Ex 12) | 25) Is the Passover Lamb (1 Cor 5:7) |

Hebrews 3:1-6 Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of a heavenly calling, consider Jesus, the Apostle and High Priest of our confession; ² ^a He was faithful to Him who appointed Him, as Moses also was in all His house. ³ For He has been counted worthy of more glory than Moses, by just so much as the builder of the house has more honor than the house. ⁴ For every house is built by someone, but the builder of all things is God. ⁵ Now Moses was faithful in all His house as a servant, for a testimony of those things which were to be spoken later; ⁶ but Christ *was faithful* as a Son over His house—whose house we are, if we hold fast our confidence and the boast of our hope firm until the end.

Moses is pointing to someone greater as he is a type and shadow pointing to Jesus. Jesus left His place of reign and glory to become a servant and a shepherd to set His people (spiritual Israel) free from slavery of the enemy and sin. As He is the Passover Lamb who was sacrificed to set His people free, Christ is the mediator of a better covenant and now intercedes for His people as they journey through the wilderness traveling to the true promised land. Moses sets the people of Israel free, but whom the Son sets free, they are free indeed!
