Psalm 103:1-22

Main Point:

Remind yourself of all the benefits you have as a child of God and bless the Lord for them.

1. God wants you to remember all the benefits you have from Him.
2. Remind yourself that God has forgiven you all your sins.
3. Remind yourself that God always deals with you in mercy and not as you deserve.
4. Remind yourself that God understands your weaknesses.
5. Remind yourself of all these benefits, so that you bless the Lord for them.
