 - A. What is contentment?
 - 1. Here "self-fulfilled" OR Satisfied with where you are and what you have
 - 2. Notice this is in reference to the material realm in the context of already possessing "godliness"
 - B. Why Should We Be Content?
 - 1. We didn't bring it in, and we can't take it out
 - 2. Contentment is the opposite of envy, greed, worry, and self-pursuit
 - C. With What Should We Be Content
 - 1. Can we eat?
 - 2. Can we be covered?
 - D. Why is this so hard?
- II. The Slippery Slope of Greed (9-10)
 - A. Setting our will on wealth
 - 1. Temptation
 - 2. Snare/Trap
 - 3. Foolish & Harmful desires
 - B. Setting our affection on wealth
 - 1. Root of all kinds of evil
 - 2. Becomes a burden rather than a blessing
- III. Chasing after the Right Thing (11-12)
 - A. Flee from this!
 - B. We are always called to pursue something else in this case:
 - 1. Righteousness

- 2. Godliness (a place where we should not be "content"
- 3. Faith
- 4. Love
- 5. Perseverance
- 6. Gentleness
- C. Fight the good fight and take hold of eternal life
- D. We should embrace the words of Agur (Proverbs 30:7-9)
