## The Significance of Lazarus' Resurrection from the Dead

1) The resurrection of Lazarus from the dead is a demonstration of Jesus' identity as the Christ, the son of God (vs. 11, 14; 5:21, 23, 26).

2) The resurrection of Lazarus from the dead is a picture of Jesus' resurrection from the dead (v. 25).

3) The resurrection of Lazarus from the dead is a picture of the believer's spiritual resurrection from the dead (Eph. 2:1, 4-6; John 3:7; 5:25).

4) The resurrection of Lazarus from the dead is a picture of the believer's physical resurrection from the dead (5:28, 29; 14:19).

## Practical Lessons

1) No case is too difficult for Jesus.

2) No greater proof of who Jesus is can be given than His power over life and death.

3) Believe and you will see the glory of God.
