


# Anatomy of the Body

(Selected Texts)



Introduction: The Human Body is the Most Amazing Work of God in the Physical Universe. The Word “Anatomy” refers to the Structure, Composition, or Make-up of the Body. What is the Anatomy of Christ’s Body (His Church)?

1. **God Designed the Body Parts as He Desired**

*1 Cor. 12:18 - But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him.*

2. **The Head of the Body Determines the Growth and Function of the Body**

*Col. 2:19 - And not holding the Head, from which all the body by joints and bands having nourishment ministered, and knit together, increaseth with the increase of God.*

3. **A Body is tied together with Unity with Diversity**

*Romans 12:4-5 - For as we have many members in one body, and all members have not the same office: [5] So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another.*

4. **All Body Parts Must Function in a Peaceful Coexistence with the Other Parts**

*Col. 3:15 - And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.*

5. **No Body Part Exists for Itself**

*Ro 14:7 - For none of us liveth to himself, and no man dieth to himself.*

6. **Every Body Part has a Unique Purpose & Function**

*1 Cor. 12:14-17 - For the body is not one member, but many. [15] If the foot shall say, Because I am not the hand, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body? [16] And if the ear shall say, Because I am not the eye, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body? [17] If the whole body were an eye, where were the hearing? If the whole were hearing, where were the smelling?*

7. **The Unattractive Body Parts are Often the Most Necessary Ones**

*1 Cor. 12:22-23 - Nay, much more those members of the body, which seem to be more feeble, are necessary: [23] And those members of the body, which we think to be less honourable, upon these we bestow more abundant honour; and our uncomely parts have more abundant comeliness.*

8. **A Dead (or inactive) Body Part Contaminates the Rest of the Body**

*1 Cor. 6:15-16 - Know ye not that your bodies are the members of Christ? shall I then take the members of Christ, and make them the members of an harlot? God forbid. [16] What? know ye not that he which is joined to an harlot is one body? for two, saith he, shall be one flesh. 1Co 5:6 Your glorying is not good. Know ye not that a little leaven leaveneth the whole lump?*

9. **Every Body Part Gives to & Takes from the Rest of the Body**

*Ephes. 4:16 - From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.*

10. **The Body Grows when each Body Part does it’s Work in Connection with the Other Parts** *(Ephesians 4:16)*

Life Produces Life (It takes Life to Produce Life)

The Pastor’s Job is not to create Life but to take care of Life

- To Provide an environment that supports & sustains life
- To Guard the Life from Sinful Contaminates and Demonic Intruders which seek to Introduce Infection to the Body
- To Create Channels to Let the Life Flow Freely

The Body’s Job is to Minister to the Other Parts of the Body in Some Beneficial Way
