Focus: KINGDOM RESTORATION. In the Last Days we await the restoration of "all things". Healing in "His Name" is a preview of things yet to come.

I. A Sign of Authority & Power

- A. The Occasion -
 - 1. A Man lame from birth, begging
 - 2. Walking and Leaping!! Luke 7:22; Isaiah 35:6
- B. The Apostle's Authority
 - Authentication they speak the truth
 - But all the credit goes to the Savior to Jesus to the Name of Jesus!

II. A Sign of the Last Days

- A. 1st sign? Pentecost! Spirit of Prophecy on all believers
- B. 2nd Sign?? This too was prophesied. Isaiah 35:6; Malachi 4:2
 - 1. Not just walking leaping!
 - 2. A Sign the Jews should recognize! (4:16, 22)
 - a. They know it is a "sign" but they reject what is signifies.
 - b. God has glorified His servant, Jesus. (13)
 - They dishonored Him vv.13-15
 - God honored Him
 - c. Ignorance is no excuse v.17

III. A Sign of Restoration

- A. Physical Restoration –
- B. Spiritual Restoration
 - 1. Points to inward change.
 - 2. It starts in responding to the call to repentance.
 - a. Repent turn to God. vv.19,26 NOTE: This is where the real healing is needed!
 - through Jesus vv.20,26

- b. Repentance brings 3-fold blessing
 - 1) Sins are wiped out/blotted out! Literally washed off/away. Wiped off the slate or papyrus (on which the ink did not penetrate.)
 - 2) Times of refreshing may come from the Lord! God adds rest, relief, refreshment for our spirits when our sins are wiped away.
 - 3) That he may send Christ appointed for you, Jesus!
- 3. Restoration is in Two Parts
 - a. *BEGUN* with Christ's death, resurrection and ascension. The Sign of this healing *Makes Visible* the inner healing, cure that faith *In His Name*, in the Power of His Name brings.
 - b. It is *COMPLETED* When He Returns!

IV. A Sign of the Power of The Name v.6,16 (4:9,10)

- A. Peter's message is thoroughly Christ-Centered (again!)
- B. He is the One whom the Scriptures foretold.
 - 1. Three Prophetic Lines are followed.
 - a. Moses vv.22, 23
 - b. The Kingdom of David v.24
 - c. The Abrahamic Covenant v.25
 - 2. He brings blessing v.26
 - Sent first to you! but not only to you
 - Repentance leading to *forgiveness*
 - Turning from wickedness to righteousness!

We are being prepared for the eternal kingdom of God in Christ. In His name is the forgiveness of sins, his promised Spirit, and the renewal, restoration of wholeness and life – that awaits His return when he will make all things new!

Conclusion: What can we say in response to this renewing work? What must we do as we walk in His Kingdom on earth?

- 1. Restoration/renewal/transformation?
- 2. Peter would say, "Silver and Gold have I none..." What do we have?
- 3. The Church has power because it has faith in Him who has all power.
