"A Sample or Substance of the Kingdom?" (Matthew 4:23–25) GCC, Morning Worship, 3/20/22

Intro-Jesus had 15 minutes of fame (v. 24). What did they come out to see?

- I. In Jesus' *preaching* and *healing* ministries, we see two important categories:
 - A. In his preaching we hear of the *substance* of the Kingdom
 - 1. The *substance* of the Kingdom is the full package, i.e., all things new (Rom 8:21)
 - B. In his healing ministry we see a *sample* of the kingdom
 - 1. Why did Jesus do these miracles? What was the purpose of them?
 - a. To authenticate his claim that He was from God (Luke 11:20)
 - b. To show that he has authority to overcome the evil one and take back the deed of the earth (Mark 3:27)
 - c. To give a sampling of the kingdom of God (Luke 11:20)
 - 2. The signs were a sample, not the substance
 - a. We must prioritize the *substance* over the *sample* (Luke 10:18-20)
- II. Does the *Sample* or the *Substance* Define and Prioritize Contentment?
 - A. Some people come to Jesus wanting to find contentment, they don't find it, are disappointed, and walk away from Jesus
 - 1. Two versions of this:
 - aa. Apostates (Heb 6:1–8)
 - bb. The Self-deceived (Matthew 7:22–24)
 - B. *True believers* come to Jesus in desperation looking for contentment. They may not even totally understand what they are looking for.
 - 1. When we come to Jesus with our 'nothing,' he redefines contentment for us and then gives it to us.
 - 2. Don't settle for the samples of the eschaton. Set your hope on the substance of the eschaton
