1. Fallen man's struggle to know how & what he knows.

2. <u>2C5:16</u> gospel affects the way we think, know.

**3.** Paul's defense - appeals to *conscience* & his *sound mind* -  $\underline{v11-13}$  In  $\underline{v16}$ , Paul gives another *Therefore* - why he is *of sound mind*.

i. <u>v14-15</u> revelation as source of knowledge

ii.Revelation of Jesus' love - controls Paul's thinking:v15 no longer live for self; v16 no longer knows according to the flesh.Our knowing correlates to our way of living: values, purpose.

iii.Jesus' love [death & res] transforms our thinking &living.

## 1st: Contrasting Two Ways of Knowing

**1.** Contrasts former way of knowing [*no longer*] w/ the way he now knows [*from now on*]. A pivot point: knowing Jesus revealed in gospel: v14-15

- **2**. Former: [v15 live for self] = *according to the flesh*: spiritually dead
- **3**. Present: *now* know according to HS <u>Rm 8:4b-9</u> [Eph 4:17; Gal 5:16-22]

i. 2 walks & 2 ways of thinking: 1] flesh, 2] Spirit

**ii**.1] Death - hostility to God, 2] life & peace & capacityto please God.

- 4. What makes the difference? LIFE resurrection life. <u>Rm 8:11</u>
- 5. Knowledge according to the flesh: saeculum

### 6. Knowledge according to the Spirit: eschatological

#### 2nd: We No Longer Know Christ According to the Flesh

**1**. Paul used to know Christ apart from His death & resurrection. Saw cross as curse [Dt 21:23] now knows Gal 3:13 *Christ became a curse for us*.

2. Apart from HS, men interpret Jesus according to the flesh - but we know Christ as Lord of heaven & earth - Col 1:15ff; enthroned - Rv 5

- **3**. Opponents were evaluating Paul according to the flesh 2C10:7
- 4. We see Jesus as did Thomas: my Lord & my God! [Jn 20:28]

### **3rd:** We No Longer Know People According to the Flesh

- **1**. <u>v16</u> *no one* = nothing
- 2. We no longer relate to people in categories of this age Gal 3:28

**3.** 2 pts of ref: 2C5:10-11 1] all -> FJ; 2] conscience - therefore *we persuade men* - convince of what conscience understands: we must be judged - Rm 1

4. We are no longer primarily concerned for the things of the flesh: we have a message for men - 2C5:20-21

5. Come to the Lord's Table & reorient yourself to what you know of His love & your union with Him. View all from the vantage point of union w/ Jesus.
