## Introduction and Background

- I. God's Perfect Timing He sends the Spirit at just the right time.
  - A. At Pentecost
    - 1. One of 3 feasts proscribed in Exodus 23 (Pentecost described in 15,16)
    - 2. 50 days -from offering of the first cutting of the barley crop. Leviticus 23:15,16
    - 3. Significance?
  - B. The People are from all over the known World!
    - 1. Great gathering Good time to travel
    - 2. Jews, Devout men (Jews and proselytes) from every land
      - a. All those of the diaspora
      - b. came with regional languages (now a "native" tongue)

*Here is the World at your doorstep – and the perfect gift is given to fulfill the mission.* Isaiah 44:8; Acts 1:8

- II. His Perfect Gift The Holy Spirit
  - A. The Presence of God
    - 1. Old Testament pictures
      - a. Wind sign of breath/spirit of God Ezekiel 37:9-10
      - b. Fire! Indicated the Presence of God!
    - 2. Tongues of Fire Matthew 3:11 Marks God's presence with the individual, not just with "the people"
  - B. The Power of God
    - 1. Declaring His Glory
    - 2. Gift of speech not of hearing! Revelation 14:6
    - 3. They are given words to speak. (Testimony requires words!)

- III. The Perfect Question "What does this mean?" Peter turns to the book of Joel to answer:
  - A. For the World?
    - 1. God has poured out his Spirit!
    - 2. What God promised over 400 years ago is happening/ being fulfilled!
    - 3. Every child of God is given/filled with the Spirit.
    - 4. His Presence with them always!! With every one who calls upon his name!
    - 5. Spirit gives power to proclaim!

What does this mean?? Why has he poured out the spirit? To take his salvation to the ends of the earth! To declare the glory of His grace and power in the fullness of the Spirit!! What does this mean...

- B. For Us Personally
  - 1. New life for those who believe
  - 2. Fire of the Spirit
    - a. His presence Colossians 1:27; Romans 8:9
    - b. His holiness
  - 3. Equipped for serving

Ultimately this means that -

- C. Christ's mission continues through us
  - 1. Israel's Mission? Declare God's glory to the world.
  - 2. The Servant's Mission? Isaiah 42:1,6,7,12; Isaiah 49:5,6
  - 3. Is Now Our Mission!

*What does this mean??* God is revealing His glory more perfectly, more fully in/through His People- by the work of the Holy Spirit in them!!
