## Are You Prepared for Eternity?

1 Cor. 10:21 Ye cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils: ye cannot be partakers of the Lord's table, and of the table of devils.

John 3:1-7 There was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews: The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles that thou doest, except God be with him. Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born? Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

- I. We speak of preparing to meet God, but few truly understand what that involves.
  - A. Most believe and are taught that it simply means performing a prayer or ritual.
  - B. Many believe that it is simply agreeing with a set of facts or creed.
  - C. There are many, many people who think all that is required is that you abstain from a few certain sins.
  - D. Many, if not most, believe that it is enough to just become a part of a church and to associate yourself with those who are known as God's people.
  - E. But being prepared to meet God involves much more than all of this.
  - F. We must become acquainted and familiar with God and the spiritual realm in which He lives.
  - G. We must also become alienated and estranged from this world and its system of life.
  - H. We must not be mindful of this world from which we have come, and we must see ourselves as strangers and pilgrims here with a mindset that looks for a city that hath foundations whose builder and maker is God.
- II. It is simply impossible for a person to go to heaven and be in the presence of God in this earthly condition.
  - A. It is a different realm and a different life altogether.
  - B. The things that are so important here on earth are not important there at all.
    - 1. Safety there will never be a pandemic, famine, recession, breakdown of law and order, or a war in heaven. (no thieves there, either)
    - 2. Cares of life there will be none there.
    - 3. Making money and getting gain no need for such things there.
    - 4. Struggling against others to keep from being taken advantage of.
    - 5. Competition against others for attention, for gain, for superiority.
  - C. The things that most consider secondary here and not so important, will be all that life is about there.
    - 1. Worship.
    - 2. Love and benevolence.
    - 3. The knowledge of God and understanding of his ways.

- 4. Pleasing God and considering him first in all things.
- III. There are things in our life that must be purged forever before we are prepared to be ushered into the presence of God forever.
  - A. Selfishness.
  - B. Worldly views and opinions that are contrary to God and his ways
  - C. Heart that is attached to the ways and the things of this world
  - D. Lack of knowledge and understanding of God himself
  - E. Head full of misinformation about God and eternity
- IV. There are some things that must be put into our very being before we are prepared to live with God forever.
  - A. Love for God
    - 1. True all consuming love, not just lip service.
    - 2. Love that surpasses all other loves.
    - 3. An intimate love that is not shared with anyone or anything else with ALL our heart, ALL our soul, ALL our mind, and ALL our strength.
    - 4. This cannot be substituted for by religious discipline or socializing with those who are known as the people of God.
  - B. A basic concept of the true reality of heaven and what it is like.
    - . It is truly beyond our ability to comprehend from where we are right now, but God has given us the means to get a glimpse.

1 Cor. 13:12 For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known.

- 2. A glimpse is sufficient to make us see the vanity of earth.
- 3. We must go beyond thinking of heaven as just a continuation of life as it is here without the bad things.
- C. A true knowledge of God and a real relationship with him here and now in this present, evil world.
  - 1. This is not something that will be initiated when we die or when Jesus comes if it ever happens, it must begin now.
  - 2. Jesus is coming for his own not those who simply have heard of him.
  - 3. Jesus is preparing a place in heaven for those who know and love God not for those who simply recognize there is a God.
  - 4. We must have a basic understanding of the ways of God and his order for his Creation.
- V. There are many, many people who are taking eternity far too lightly.
  - A. They are skipping through life thinking that since they have said a prayer and they say they are saved, and they associate with God's people a little, that they are safe and that after they die they will be in heaven with all their troubles behind them.
  - B. They know little or nothing about God and his character, his ways, his heart, because they neglect to read and study his Word.
  - C. All the evidence of their life shows that they are in love with the world and not with God.
    - 1. They are much at home here and therefore are strangers to heaven.
  - D. All of us need to examine ourselves and make sure that we are truly prepared and ready to step into the presence of God at any moment.
