# "Trusting the Lord for the Next Generation" Psalm 127

A call to consider those things that endure, and to trust God in their establishment.

1. Trusting in God Alone for the Building of His House vv. 1-2

# (1) The futility of every endeavor undertaken without God's help

-1- The building of the house "Unless the LORD builds the house, All is futile, if God's hand is not in the building! "Unless the LORD guards the city, The watchman stays awake in vain."

## -2- The guarding of the city

#### -2- Children are <u>a gift</u> from God!

- Heb: nachalah - possession, property, inheritance NASV "gift"

- We have no control in determining this!

- It is wholly of the goodness and mercy of God that we have children!

-3- A reward! - Heb: Sacar - hire, wages; a reward for work done

# (2) Children: a primary means through which God will establish His Kingdom

-1- We are called to see in them a wonderful	"Like arrows in the hands of a warrior
promise of strength and blessing.	so are the children of one's youth."

- When you look at your children, grandchildren, what do you see?

#### -3- The labor expended with the hope that one's work will endure.

- Excessive labor will do no good at all if God's hand is not in it to bless.

"It is vain for you to rise up early, To sit up late, To eat the bread of sorrows"

#### -2- Happy is the man who views his children in this way! "Happy is the man who has his quiver full of them"

### -3- God purposes to bless the generation to come!

"They shall not be ashamed, But shall speak with their enemies in the gate."

### (2) The promise of rest for those who are trusting in the Lord

"For so He gives His beloved sleep."

- There is a rest which God's people may enjoy if they are trusting in Him!

- Still laboring, but trusting God amidst the labor!
