- Unbeliever resists the Holy Spirit, the believer grieves the Holy Spirit
- NT mentions 6 offenses that can be committed against the Holy Spirit
- 1. The Holy Spirit can be lied to (Acts 5:1-11)
- 2. The Holy Spirit can be grieved (Eph 4:30,31)
- 3. The Holy Spirit can be quenched (1 Thess 5:19)
- 4. The Holy Spirit can be resisted (Acts 7:51)
- 5. The Holy Spirit can be insulted (Heb 10:29)
- 6. The Holy Spirit can be blasphemed (Matt 12:31-32)
 - I. Do Not Grieve the Holy Spirit (4:30)
- And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God -
- Eph 1:13 you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise
- The Holy Spirit can be grieved He is a person not a force
- The relationship we have with the Holy Spirit is personal

II. How Do we Grieve the Holy Spirit

- Anything which is of the flesh grieves Him (Gal 5:19)
- We grieve Him with impure thoughts & with our words
- We grieve Him when we resist His prompting (Ph 2:13)

III. Why Shouldn't we Grieve the Holy Spirit

- by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption
- Glory awaits, we are all being prepared for perfection
- (1 Peter 1:9-11)
