

The resurrection of Jesus Christ took place between 6pm Saturday evening (Sunday for the Jews) and 6am Sunday morning. Sunrise in AD 30 meant it had to have been before 5am on Sunday morning.

Feast of Unleavened Bread - Points to the sinless life of Christ. Like wheat planted and waiting to burst forth as the bread of life. Feast of First Fruits points to Christ as the
