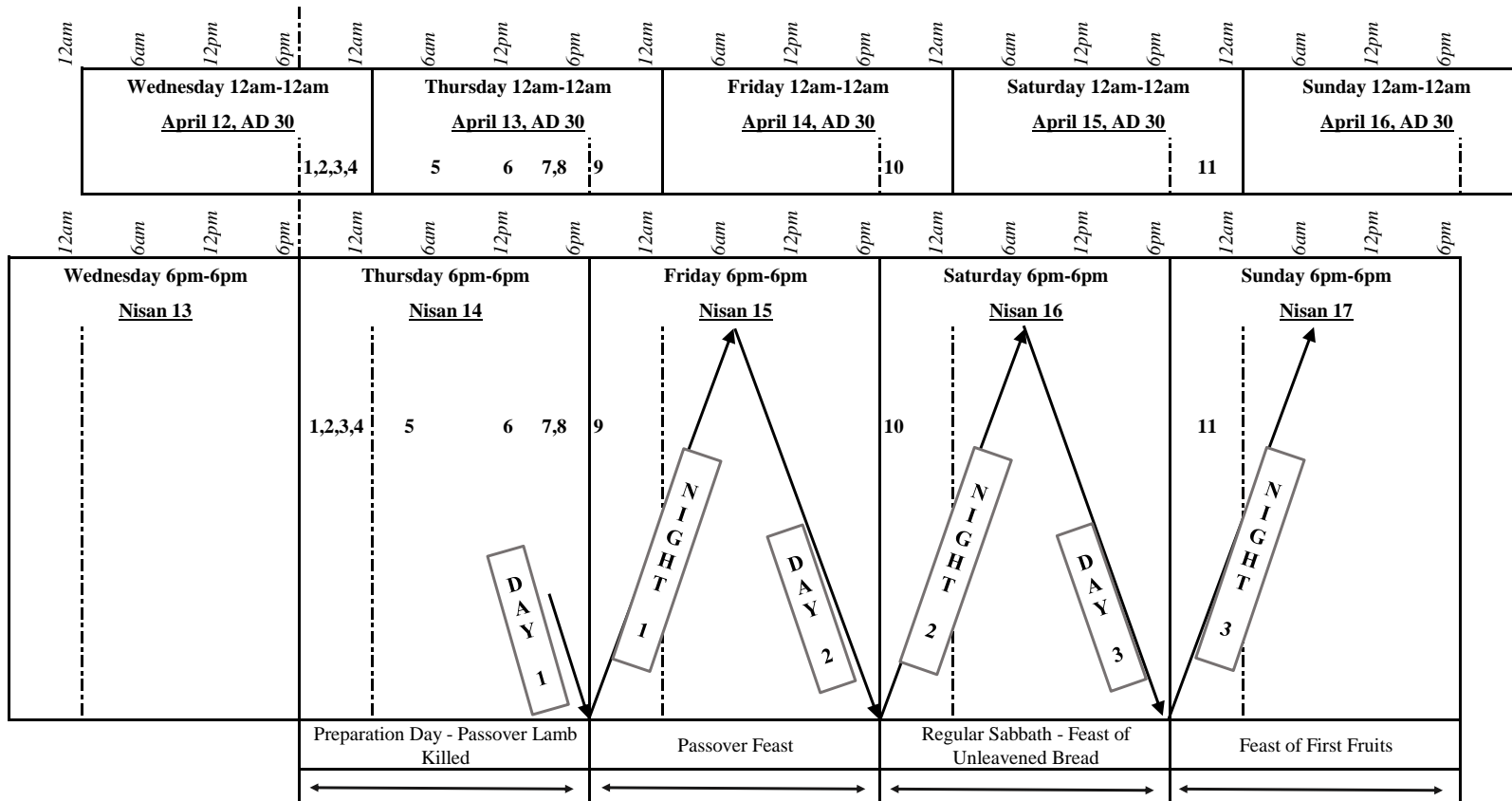


## The Days & Times of the Death, Burial, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ
