#### **Gnostic Texts Leave Out "On Me"**

Everlasting life is the life that Christ came to bring. It is important to notice that the new Bible versions based on the Gnostic critical Greek text leave out the two words, "on me." They just translate it to read "he that believes has everlasting life." Everyone in the world needs the Lord Jesus Christ. He is the only One Who has brought life and immortality to those who are saved.

#### The Preacher As A "Herald"

A preacher is a KERUX. This word means:

"a herald, a messenger vested with public authority who conveyed the official message of kings and magistrates, princes, and military commanders. He gave a public summons or demand and performed various other duties."
