"Jesus – King of Glory and of Grace!" Revelation 22:12-17

Revelation #53

The final divine testimony concerning what is revealed in the book of Revelation.

1. Jesus, the King of Glory, will bring in the Consummation of All Things!

vv. 12-15 (1) Jesus is the Judge of all men! "Behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to give to everyone according to his work." - He comes to judge. He is coming quickly! "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last." (2) Jesus is the Sovereign over all of history! "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the Last." - Drawn from Is. 41:4; 44:6; 48:12 "I am the Alpha and the Last." - Ascribed to the Father in 1:8. Used by the Lamb in 1:11, 17; 2:8 - Here again Jesus very clearly claims the same attribute for Himself. Jesus is the Sovereign over all of history!

(3) Jesus brings a Great Divide! (14-15)

- Those who wash their robes!

- -1- The Blessed
- (ESV) "Blessed are those who wash their robes, so that they might have the right to the tree of life, and that they may enter the city by the gates."
- cf. 7:14 This washing comes only by faith in the shed blood of the Lamb!

2. Jesus, the King of Grace, yet Offers Salvation to All Men! vv. 16-17

- (1) Jesus Himself testifies of these things! "I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things in the churches."
 - ESV "to testify to you about these things in the churches"
