

Happy New Year!

As far as our church is concerned, we received a message from the city owning the building, saying that everyone has to vacate the building because they were unable to afford the natural gas bill. For the time being, we have taken over the natural gas bill and are the only occupant. The city will be putting the building up for sale, and we do not know what the future holds. We are unsure of how much the building will be sold for and we do not know whether or not we will purchase the building. Prayers are appreciated for funding and knowledge about what to do next.

Our church meets regularly every Sunday morning and Thursday night. With the help of the American teachers, we were able to hold a Thanksgiving meal with our members. Thanksgiving usually isn't celebrated in Poland, but we love this tradition, so we do it anyway. We also held a Christmas meal and fellowshipped together as a church on Christmas. Our church members went to the local Christmas market in Libiaz, where we made various contacts, passed out Biblical tracts and Bibles, and presented the Mayor of the town with a Bible. You can be praying about the seeds planted

Due to the rising cost of living and inflation, we have had a slight drop in student count at the preschool. There is an opportunity to expand our other preschool. The facility is owned by residents, and they voted for us to expand the preschool. Pray we will find a way to renovate and expand the preschool and find a way to finance this.

In the beginning of December, we located a new facility for our camp this year. It will be held July 2-8, 2023 in the mountains in Zakopane. We had to look for a larger facility because our camp last year, sold out in May, so we are expecting more campers this year. Pray for staff, as a lot of our helpers last year are unable to attend this year. (The majority of the staff from last year are heavily involved in Ukrainian aid, which is why they are unable to attend.) This upcoming year, we will be sponsoring several Ukrainian children in our camp, so prayers for them and all of our campers would also be appreciated.

We are constantly supporting people who are making regular trips to Ukraine. We are closely working with a missionary that our church support, named Konrad who is publishing Evangelistic materials in Ukrainian language. Churches in Ukraine are full of people right now, which presents us with the opportunity to print a lot of Evangelical materials and send New Testaments. Currently, we are printing the Gospel of Mark and working on sending them to Ukraine. We are also putting together 100 packages for the orphaned children from Bucha, where it was discovered there was torture and very gruesome things happening to the Ukrainian people. The packages are for those who either lost their parents at war or whose parents are involved in the war.

We are still in contact with the Ukrainian family we hosted. Despite the fact that there have been attacks and shortages of power, the family is safe. Utility is the main problem in Ukraine right now. You can be praying about the situations there and the safety of all of the families and people involved.
