Sermon Text: Luke 24:1-49 Risen Indeed!

The risen Lord is graciously presented to us in the Word of God.

- 1) Remembering the words of Jesus (1-12)
 - a) Risen Lord perplexing to forgetful faith (1-4)
 - i) Gentle rebuke of forgetful faith (5-6a)
 - ii) Reminder of Christ's words (6b-7)
 - b) Risen Lord encountered in remembrance of His words (8)
 - i) Report to the Apostles (9-10)—first witnesses
 - ii) Disbelief of the Apostles (11)—external testimony alone ineffectual
 - iii) Peter's wonder (12)
 - c) **Application**: Wonder Restored
- 2) Believing the Scriptures (13-32)
 - a) Risen Lord concealed to eyes of flesh (13-25)
 - b) Risen Lord revealed in Scripture to eyes of faith (26-27, 32)
 - i) Jesus' "walk through the Bible" whets our appetite to return to the Old Testament Scriptures with the spectacles of the Gospel of Christ.
 - ii) Christ is revealed in the whole and in the parts. Avoid errors of Christless readings.
 - c) Risen Lord revealed in Sacrament to eyes of faith (28-31)
 - i) Adam and Eve had their eyes opened to see ruin of creation because of sin.
 - ii) Cleopas and companion had their eyes opened to see new creation because of Christ.
 - d) Application: Hope Restored
- 3) Hearing the Apostolic witness of the Spirit (33-49)
 - a) Risen Lord appeared to Apostles
 - i) The Lord appeared to Peter (33-34)
 - ii) The Lord appeared to Cleopas and companion (35)
 - iii) The Lord appeared to the eleven and those with them (36-43)
 - b) Risen Lord instructs the witnesses with the Word (44-48)
 - c) Risen Lord empowers the witnesses with the Spirit (49)
 - d) Application: Mission Restored
