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Discussion Questions

The following questions are designed to be used by parents in discussing the sermon with their children, but can be used by anyone in discussing the sermon with others:

1. What stood out to you in this sermon? Why?
2. Who were “the twelve” (verse 7)?
3. What did Christ commission the twelve to do?
4. Why were the twelve to bring very little with them?
5. How was the ministry of the Twelve similar to the ministry of Christ? How was it different?
6. What does it mean to repent?
7. How was the ministry of the twelve authenticated? What does this mean?
8. Have you repented of your sins? Explain.

Going Deeper:

These questions are designed for the believer to use in prayer with his/her Lord, and in discussion with brothers and sisters in the Lord:

1. How did this sermon challenge your thinking, or grow your understanding?
2. How does this passage apply to Christian ministry today?
3. How would you define *repentance* to someone who has never been in a church nor read the Bible?
4. How does repentance compare to just changing your behavior?
5. How does repentance compare to just confessing your sin?
6. Why is it important to have a good understanding of repentance?
7. How prominent should the call to repent be in our gospel presentations? Explain.
8. What is the number one way you should be affected by this sermon this week?
