

Pamagat: The LORD's Controversy Against the Priests and Prophets (Religious Leaders)

Hosea 4:5 "Therefore shalt thou fall in the day, and **the prophet also shall fall** with thee in the night, and I will destroy thy mother.

6 **My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge**: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, **that thou shalt be no priest to me**: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children. 7 As they were increased, so they sinned against me: therefore will I change their glory into shame. 8 They eat up the sin of my people, and they set their heart on their iniquity. 9 And there shall be, like people, like priest: and I will punish them for their ways, and reward them their doings. 10 For they shall eat, and not have enough: they shall commit whoredom, and shall not increase: because they have left off to take heed to the LORD. 11 Whoredom and wine and new wine take away the heart."

Panimula:

- 1. Last week we saw the controversy of the LORD against the people, today we will look at the LORD's controversy against the religious leaders (priests and prophets).
- 2. This is the LORD's commentary on Israel and here in vv.5-11 God has a controversy (charge) with the priests and the prophets the religious leaders of Israel.
 - 2.1. The People will fall.
 - 2.2. The Prophet will fall.
 - 2.3. The Priest will fall.

I. <u>The People are Destroyed for their Lack of Knowledge</u>.

- A. Of His words (the law of thy God), and of His ways (Holiness)
- B. When the priest doesn't speak the truth, the people will be ignorant and sin.
- C. Spiritual ignorance is no excuse.

II. <u>The People are Destroyed for following their Religious Leaders.</u>

- A. I will forget thy children. (v.6b) the entire kingdom and people of Israel.
- B. I will change their glory into shame. (v.7b) degrade their people and priests.
- C. I will punish them for their ways and reward them their doings. (v.9b)

<u>Katapusan</u>:

- 1. Backsliding is here described: (v.10b) "they have left off to take heed to the LORD."
 - Review: (1:2 departing from the LORD; 2:13 forgat me, saith the LORD) this is the state of their backsliddeness. They have apostatized or turned from the true God.
- 2. Whoredom (Immorality) and wine and new wine (Drunkenness) take away the heart.
- 3. The heart of the problem is a problem of the heart.
