**Sermon Title: Signs of an Unbelieving Heart**

- I. You are unconcerned about the truth. (1-2)**
  - A. You manipulate the truth. (Matthew 27:1-2)
  
  - B. You mock the truth. (Luke 22:63-65)
  
  - C. You ignore the truth. (Luke 22:66-70)
  
- II. You are unhappy with your life. (3-5)**
  - A. You lose control of the present. (3a)
  
  - B. You dwell on poor decisions made in the past. (3b-4)
  
  - C. You see no hope for the future. (5)
  
- III. You are unwilling to get honest. (6-7)**
  - A. You hide behind a code of conduct that you cannot keep. (6)
  
  - B. You hope your good will outweigh your bad. (7)
  
- IV. You are unable to see God. (8-10)**
  - A. You miss the obvious. (8)
  
  - B. You miss the miraculous. (9-10)

### **Apply the Text:**

- **Unconcerned with the truth. (1-2)**
  - Speak the truth in love; Memorize Phil. 4:8.
- **Unhappy with your life. (3-5)**
  - Accept God's forgiveness; Trust God's sovereignty.
- **Unwilling to get honest. (6-7)**
  - Stop hiding behind a list of rules; Rest in the righteousness of Jesus Christ.
- **Unable to see God. (8-10)**
  - Look for Him in creation; Search for Him in Scripture.
