## Introduction: Revelation 1:18

*I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.*

1. Our theme verse..
2. Our situation...Moses: God sent the plagues on Egypt and sent Moses to pharaoh, to let my people go, so they could turn / worship.
  1. Joshua was chosen to lead them in and occupy...
  2. Samuel was sent to turn the people back to the true and living God.
3. We as believers have the Spirit of the true and living God. **2 Corinthians 3:1-3 2**

*Forasmuch as ye are manifestly declared to be the epistle of Christ ministered by us, written not with ink, but with the **Spirit of the living God**; not in tables of stone, but in fleshy tables of the heart.*

### **Note:**

God makes us pure by His sovereign grace, but we have something to look after, this bodily life by which we come in contact with other people and with other points of view; it is these that are apt too sully. Not only must the inner sanctuary be kept

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right with God, but the outer courts as well are to be brought into perfect accord with the purity God gives us by His grace. The spiritual understanding is blurred immediately the outer court is sullied. If we are going to retain personal contact with the Lord Jesus Christ, it will mean there are some things we must scorn to do or to think, some legitimate things we must scorn to touch.

A practical way of keeping personal purity unsullied in relation to other people is to say to yourself — That man, that woman, perfect in Christ Jesus! That friend, that relative, perfect in Christ Jesus!

4. We are His epistle, and an epistle is a letter...

**1 Timothy 4:13**

*Till I come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine.*

**Colossians 4:16**

*And when this epistle is read among you, cause that it be read also in the church of the Laodiceans; and that ye likewise read the epistle from Laodicean.*

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5. We have to get the believer today back to the word of God... (**My job as a ordained preacher,**)

**Statement:**

If you move away from the knowledge of the Bible, the believer with all sincerity and enthusiasm believe that he or she has turned to the true and living God...

**Lesson:**

To help us we are going to start this series with the Book of Daniel the last part of the Old

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Testament and events leading up to it, and the book of Revelation the last part of the New Testament.

1. Start to finish.
2. This will lesson will largely focus on Daniel seventieth week...
  1. You need to get this right in order to quench the myths and misunderstandings “about the True and living God.
  2. We make no apologies to Pastors, churches, Extra ...because this is what the Bible teaches.
  3. The purpose of these studies is to strengthen your faith and understanding in the true and living God.

A. We start with Samuel..( 2000 years Genesis )

Matthew 24:15

When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:)

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Jesus Christ makes it clear that the book of Daniel didn't just contain historical historical prophecy spoken by Daniel, but was referring to what Jesus called a time that world hasn't not seen before  
Matthew 24:21 For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be. We pray that this study will help the Bible believing Christian understand this prophecy which is yet to be fulfilled.

Explanation: From the book of Daniel we can see Gods plan for the ages, and at the outset of this study when it is important to note that scripture clearly teaches that prophecy is not fully understood until after the event. Therefore it is important that we use the word consideration in light of scripture, especial with this subject so as not to mislead about something that has not been fulfilled yet.

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To understand Daniels seethe week, it begins with Gods plan to lead his people into captivity under the preaching of Jeremiah and the end of what is known as the time of the Kings. The key to this entire lesson begins with Israel while dwelling in the promise land after God had moved them from the land of Canan, into the land of Egypt, through the wilderness and back in again. But Israel wandered while in the land and God sent Samuel the Prophet to turn the people back to the true and living God.

1 Samuel 8:7

And the Lord said unto Samuel, Hearken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto thee: for they have not rejected thee, but they have rejected me, that I should not reign over them.

They wanted a King like all the other nations, and God gave Israel their choice which was Saul, where they could have waited for Gods choice which was David to be their King ( David a type of Christ and Saul a type of the anti-christ.) When King David died Solomon reigned.

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2 Chronicles 6:10

The Lord therefore hath performed his word that he hath spoken: for I am risen up in the room of David my father, and am set on the throne of Israel, as the Lord promised, and have built the house for the name of the Lord God of Israel.

After Solomon we have Rehoboam Solomons son and Jeroboam an official of Solomons. God divided the kingdom because of Rehoboam turning the people back to idols 1 King 11:13. God sends Ahijah to Jeroboam and offers the ten northern tribes to him 1 Kings 11:29-34.

Now we come to an important lesson, Rehoboam wars with the north and to take the ten tribes back, when God sends 1 Kings 12:21-23 Shinemiah the man of God saying:

1 Kings 12:24

Thus saith the Lord, Ye shall not go up, nor fight against your brethren the children of Israel: return every man to his house; for this thing is from me.

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They hearkened therefore to the word of the Lord, and returned to depart, according to the word of the Lord.

This same lesson that it is Gods doing how will reign and who will not..

Daniel 4:25

That they shall drive thee from men, and thy dwelling shall be with the beasts of the field, and they shall make thee to eat grass as oxen, and they shall wet thee with the dew of heaven, and seven times shall pass over thee, till thou know that the most High roulette in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will.

At the time of Daniel there was Jeremiah the Prophet and Ezeiel. Jeremiah prophecy was to tell the children of Israels Gods plan to send them into captivity supported by Ezeiel. The false prophets of the day were preaching that God was going to fix things after the first siege on Jerusalem, where King Nebuchadnezzar carried away the vessels of the temple and the Daniel was carried into

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captivity, as prophesied by Isaiah 39:3 concerning the kings seed.

This brings us to our lesson: Daniel 9:24  
Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.

And the seventy years of captivity in Babylon:  
Jeremiah 25:12

And it shall come to pass, when seventy years are accomplished, that I will punish the king of Babylon, and that nation, saith the Lord, for their iniquity, and the land of the Chaldeans, and will make it perpetual desolations.

2 Chronicles 36:21-22.

And them that had escaped from the sword carried he away to Babylon; where they were servants to him and his sons until the reign of the kingdom of Persia: To fulfil the word of the Lord by the mouth

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of Jeremiah, until the land had enjoyed her sabbaths: for as long as she lay desolate she kept sabbath, to fulfil threescore and ten years.

These seventy years were fulfilled, but the seventweeks that are determined upon my people is where we will begin, first with the explanation from the scriptures what the word "weeks represent"
