

Jesus' Triumphal Entry into Daniel's Presence

Daniel 10:1-5-9

Daniel: God's Sovereign Rule
Over Human History, part 32

- One of the chief ways Satan delights to defeat and discourage us is to keep us from seeking God in prayer. The neglect of prayer leads to _____ Christians, _____ families, and _____ churches.
- This glorious man who meets Daniel is either a THEOPHANY or a MIGHTY ANGEL. While at first I was honestly unsure of who this was, I have become assured that it is Jesus (a Theophany)
- The major objection to this angelic messenger (of vv.5-9) being Christ is this: the angel described in verses 10-14 is inferior to the Lord, for he needed the help of Michael. If this angel speaking in verses 10-14 is the same angel Daniel sees in verses 5-9, it would seem that this is not the Lord (in vv.5-9). The best answer to this is that Daniel sees Christ in a vision and he falls down as dead into a deep sleep in vv.5-9. The Lord leaves, and then another angel touches him in verse 10. This is reasonable because of a clear break between vv. 9 & 10, and then at least four other interpreting angels appear to Daniel in these final chapters after this one vision of Jesus (10:11, 16, 19; 12:5).
- The Lord comes in unique ways to His special servants, in a way compatible with the circumstances of their calling. He comes to the anointed prophet Daniel as “_____,” a Kingly Messianic Priest.
- Let's look at three major reasons why this glorious being is our Lord Jesus Christ:
 1. **The Introduction: Behold _____, v.5**
 - This reminds us of:
 - A. The transfiguration of Jesus: “They saw no man, save _____.” (Matt.17:8)
 - B. When Pilate introduced Jesus to his accusers: “_____!” (John 19:5)
 2. **The Description: Behold the _____, v.6**
 - A. The **Priest** of _____

Rev.1:13; One like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle.

B. The **Prophet** with _____

Rev.1:14; His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes were a flame of fire.

C. The **King** of _____

Rev. 1:15; And his feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and his voice as the sound of many waters.

A. Daniel's Friends _____
(reminding us of Paul's experience on the Damascus Road) v.7

Acts 9:7; And the men which journeyed with him stood speechless, hearing a voice, but seeing no man. (Acts 22:9; Acts 26:13)

B. Daniel _____
(reminding us of John's experience on the Isle of Patmos), vv.8-9

Revelation 1:17; And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid His right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last.
