³¹ Then He took the twelve aside and said to them, "Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and all things that are written by the prophets concerning the Son of Man will be accomplished. ³² For He will be delivered to the Gentiles and will be mocked and insulted and spit upon. ³³ They will scourge *Him* and kill Him. And the third day He will rise again." ³⁴ But they understood none of these things; this saying was hidden from them, and they did not know the things which were spoken.

Ephesians 1:4-9 ⁴ **He** chose us in **Him** before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before **Him**. Ephesians 2:1-6 ¹ And you were dead in the trespasses and sins ² in which you once walked, following the course of this world, following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience ³ among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind. ////// ⁴ But **God**, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which **He** loved us, ⁵ even when we were dead in our trespasses, **He** made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved— ⁶ and raised us up with **Him** and seated us with **Him** in the heavenly places in **Christ Jesus**,

Romans 9:10-24 ¹⁰ And not only so, but also when Rebekah had conceived children by one man, our forefather Isaac, ¹¹ though they were not yet born and had done nothing either good or bad—in order that **God's purpose** of election might continue, not because of works

but because of Him who calls— ¹² she was told, "The older will serve the younger." ¹³ As it is written, "Jacob I loved, but Esau I hated." ¹⁴ What shall we say then? Is there injustice on God's part? By no means! ¹⁵ For He says to Moses, "**I will have mercy** on whom **I have mercy**, and **I will have compassion** on **whom I have compassion.**" ¹⁶ So then it **depends not** on human will or exertion, **but on God**, who has mercy. ¹⁷ For the Scripture says to Pharaoh, "For this very purpose **I** have raised you up, that **I** might show **My power** in you, and that **My name** might be proclaimed in all the earth." ¹⁸ So then **He** has mercy on whomever **He wills**, and **He hardens** whomever **He wills**. ¹⁹ You will say to me then, "Why does **He still find fault?** For who can resist **His will?**" ²⁰ But who are you, O man, to answer back to **God?** Will what is molded say to its **molder**, "Why have you made me like this?" ²¹ Has the **potter** no right over the clay, to make out of the same lump one vessel for honorable use and another for dishonorable use? ²² What if **God**, desiring to show **His wrath** and to make known **His power**, has endured with much patience vessels of wrath **prepared for destruction**, ²³ in order to make known the riches of **His glory** for vessels of mercy, which **He has prepared** beforehand for glory— ²⁴ even us whom **He has called**, not from the Jews only but also from the Gentiles?

John 1:12-13 ¹² But to all who did receive Him, who believed in His name, He gave the right to become children of God, ¹³ who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, **but of God.**

1 Corinthians 2:14 The lost person does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are folly to him, and he is not able to understand them because they are spiritually discerned (appraised).
