8:38 = He comes 9:41 = Rewards in future 9:43,45,47 = Punishment future 10:14 = Kingdom of God 10:30 = Age to come 12:26 = Dead rise

## HE WANTS IT TOBE CENTRAL IN OUR LIVES.

- 1. Lk 17:26-27 = Noah's neighbors were so busy in the present that they missed the future.
- 2. 2 Th 2:1-2; 3:1-6-15 = Thessalonian Christians were so busy with the future they missed the present.
- 3. Rev 2:8-11 = Smyrniots were alert to both the present and the future...
- Now, Ch. 13 is an entire chapter about the future with the theme of "being alert" to Christ's return.

Remember - Jesus states 4 enemies of expectancy. 4 attacks we must guard against.

- > First is negative 'don't sleep or be sleepless'.
- Second is positive 'be wide awake' as in a marketplace surrounded by opportunity...paul uses this in the sense of buying up the time.
