Responsive Reading

Leader: Which is the tenth commandment?

People: The tenth commandment is, Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor’s house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbor’s wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor anything that is thy neighbor’s.

Leader: What is required in the tenth commandment?

People: The tenth commandment requires full contentment with our own condition, with a right and charitable frame of spirit toward our neighbor, and all that is his.

Leader: What is forbidden in the tenth commandment?

People: The tenth commandment forbids all discontentment with our own estate, envying or grieving at the good of our neighbor, and all inordinate motions and affections to anything that is his. (Shorter Catechism 79-81)

Corporate Confession of Sin

Leader: Creator and Sustainer of the Universe, Provider of all good things, hear our cry for mercy as we confess our sins to you.

People: Gracious and loving God and Father, we confess that we have not been content with our own lot in life, even discontented with all you have given us; and we have been jealous of our neighbor’s well being.

All: LORD God, be gracious to us and forgive our sins.
