**A. RESOLUTION IN THE SPIRIT** (18,20f,25; see 15:2,13f,22,28)

### B. CORRECTION NEEDED TO DISRUPTIVE MISUNDERSTANDING (21; see c.15)

- 1. the Gospel: only Christ's obedience saves us (20:21,24; see Rom.3:21f; Eph.2:1-10)
- 2. Gentiles not obligated to become Jews in order to become Christians (25; 15:19f,29 /Titus, Gal.2:3)
- 3. Jews are not obligated to become Gentiles in order to become Christians (21f/Tim., 16:3 /other traditions)
- 4. J & G free from all traditions so make disciples (1Cor.9:19-23; see Gal.5:13f,1f; Col.2:20f; Mt.28:19)
- C. PAUL BECOMES A JEW FOR THE SAKE OF THE JEWS (20f,26; see 1Cor.9:20,22-23)
- **D. PAUL YIELDED TO FRIENDS' CONVICTION** (18-26; see Jms.3:17)

# **CONCLUSION: FOLLOW THE LEADER** (c.21)

#### A. SEEK CONVICTION FROM THE HOLY SPIRIT

- 1. persevere in your own convictions when necessary (7-14; Mt.16:23; Heb.10:35f)
- 2. yield to the convictions of others when serviceable (17-26; Jms.3:17; 1Cor.9:20f)
- **B. APPLY MORAL TESTS FOR FOLLOWING SPIRIT** (Gal.5:16-26; Rom.8:13,14; see Is.30:21; 63:10-14)
