

# The Signs and Events of the End

## Daniel 12:1–13

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### I. The Book (Da. 12:4)

- A. \_\_\_\_\_ up the words refers to the cessation of revelation concerning these prophetic events (Rev. 22:19; Psa. 12:6–7; Prov. 30:5–6).
- B. \_\_\_\_\_ the Book refers to the preservation of the whole book of prophecy.
1. The Preservation of God's Word (Psa. 12:6–7)

- A. Many shall run to and fro.

### IV. The Timing and Events of the End (Da. 12:11–12)

- A. 1260 days—the set-up of the abomination until the second coming of Christ (Da. 12:7).
1. A “time” is a \_\_\_\_\_ (Da. 4:25; 7:25)
  2. 42 months (Rev. 13:5–7)
  3. The first 3.5 years of the tribulation will be the implementation of the antichrist's peace plan after he makes his covenant with Israel (Da. 9:27).
  4. The last 3.5 years of tribulation the Lord will finish by bringing His people Israel to a place of repentance under the great persecution of the antichrist (Da. 12:7; Rev. 12:6, 14).
- B. 1290 days—the set-up to the end of the abomination of desolation (Da. 12:11).
1. The \_\_\_\_\_ of the abomination of desolation.
  2. The antichrist and false prophet will be cast \_\_\_\_\_ into the Lake of Fire (Rev. 19:20).
    - a. The antichrist will be \_\_\_\_\_ with Christ's coming (2 Thess. 2:8–9).
    - b. The antichrist may be immediately resurrected after his death (Isa. 14:20).

- 1) The first resurrection with Christ as its first fruits is the resurrection of the righteous (1 Jo. 2:1).
  - 2) The second resurrection with the antichrist as its first fruits is the resurrection of the wicked (2 Thess. 2:3; Rev. 17:11).
3. Satan will be \_\_\_\_\_ and cast into the bottomless pit (Rev. 20:1–3).
- a. Satan experiences \_\_\_\_\_ (Ez. 28:14; Rev. 20:1–2).

- C. 1335 days—the setup of the abomination of desolation up to the blessing of the kingdom (Da. 12:12; Matt. 10:21–22)
1. Jesus Christ \_\_\_\_\_ righteous Israel into the Promised Land (Rev. 1:7; Matt. 24:29–31; Deut. 28:36–37; Jer. 25:11; Deut. 28:25; 63–67; 30:1–6).
  2. The resurrection of the Old Testament saints and tribulation martyrs (Da. 12:2–3).
  3. The harvest of the \_\_\_\_\_ (Matt. 13:24–30; 24:36–44; Isa. 26:20–21)
  4. The Judgment of the \_\_\_\_\_
    - a. The timing, location, and grounds of the judgment (Joel 3:1–3).
      - 1) The judgment is in conjunction with the regathering of Israel.
      - 2) The location of the judgment is the \_\_\_\_\_ of Jehoshaphat.
      - 3) The grounds for the judgment will be their treatment of \_\_\_\_\_ during the Tribulation (Ge. 12:1–3).
    - b. The result of the judgment (Matt. 25:31–46)
      - 1) The blessing of the sheep (Matt. 25:34).
