Recap & Trouble Shooting

"But I ask, have they not heard?" - 10:18

- Yes they have!

"But I ask, did Israel not understand?" (10:19)

- Disobedience was the problem, not difficulty

"I ask then, has God rejected his people?" (11:1)

- No way! No way! by no means!
 - Paul demonstrates this personally... and prophetically
 - ...and presently.

"What then? Israel failed to obtain what it was seeking. The elect obtained it, but the rest were hardened." (11:7)

"So I ask, did they stumble in order that they might fall?" (11:11)

- No! Israel's hardening is neither total, nor final.
 - Envy with good intent.
 - But don't become proud... continue in his kindness.

"But if it is by grace, it is no longer on the basis of works; otherwise grace would no longer be grace."

(Romans 11:6)
