- ¹⁵ Then, the Pharisees went and I took counsel together so that they might ensnare Him in word.
- And they send to Him their disciples, with the Herodians, saying, "Teacher, we know that You are true, and *that* the way of God in truth You are teaching, and *that* it does not matter to You concerning anyone, for you do not regard² the status³ of men.
- ¹⁷ "Therefore, say to us what it seems *like* to You: is it allowable to give poll tax to Caesar, or not?"
- ¹⁸ But Jesus, because He knew their wickedness, said,

"Why are you trying to test Me, hypocrites?

- ¹⁹ "Display for Me the coin for the poll-tax." And they brought Him a denarius.
- ²⁰ And He says to them, "Whose *is* this image and the inscription?"
- ²¹ They say to Him, "Caesar's." Then He says to them, "Therefore repay the things of Caesar to Caesar— and the things of God to God!"
- ²² And when they heard, they marveled; and they left Him and⁴ went away.
