Main Point: God sufficiently confirmed the gospel preached by the Apostles by the signs and wonders done through them.

I. History: A Brief History of Signs & Wonders.

Three Major Periods.

- 1) the time of Moses & Joshua ~1525-1375 BC
- 2) the time of Elijah & Elisha ~875-797 BC
- 3) the time of Christ & the Apostles ~4 BC - 98 AD

II. Warning: The Danger of Signs & Wonders.

III. Clarification: The Purpose of Signs & Wonders.
