1. WHAT IS MEANT BY "GOD IS INFINITE"?

- A. Let's Understand the Word "Infinite"!
- → "Infinite" = "lacking limits or bounds; extending beyond measure or comprehension; without beginning or end; endless" (WNWD, p. 721).
- B. Let's Understand that God is Infinite!
- → QUOTE: "He is actually Infinite Being (not a series) and cannot be added to in any way" (Norman Geisler, Systematic Theology, 2:125).

- → How is God infinite?
- A. God is Infinite in His Understanding
 - → Psalm 147:5
- B. God is Infinite in His Thoughts toward His People!
 - → Psalm 40:5
- *** God's thoughts are SO FAR BEYOND US!

 ISAIAH 55:8-9
- *** God's thoughts toward His People are filled with HOPE!
 - → 1FRFMTAH 29:11

 - 1. Solomon's Amazing O
 - → 1 Kings 8:27a
- → "But will God indeed dwell on the earth?"
 - a. Solomon had finished building the Temple for the LORD

 → 1 Kings 7:51
 - b. The Priests brought the Ark of the LORD into the Temple
 → 1 Kings 8:4, 6-7
 - c. The Glory of the LORD filled the Temple
 - → 1 Kings 8:9-11

- d. Solomon said LORD would dwell in the dark cloud→ 1 Kings 8:12
- e. He tells the LORD that He had built "an exalted house" for Him! → 1 Kings 8:13
- f. Solomon prays with hands toward heaven
 - → 1 Kings 8:22

He speaks to:

- 1) His Uniqueness—8:23
- 2) His Promise Keeping—8:24
- 3) His Covenant-Keeping—8:25
- g. He asks an amazing question→ 1 Kings 8:27
 - 1) The Temple was built
 - 2) The Glory had entered it
 - 3) But, Solomon knew what a wonder it was that the Infinite God would manifest His presence on earth in a temple made with hands!!
- 2. Solomon's Wise S
- → 1 Kings 8:27b
- → "Behold, heaven and the heaven of heavens cannot contain You."
 - a. Heaven cannot contain the LORD

- b. The Heaven of Heavens cannot contain the LORD
- c. God is beyond the highest imaginable places
 - 1) Nothing will "hold Him in"
 - 2) He needs nothing or no one to sustain Him
- 3. Solomon's Dramatic E
- → 1 Kings 8:27c
- → "How much less this temple which I have built!"
 - a. If Heaven can't contain the Lord, neither can a temple!
 - b. Men can't build a container for God!
 - c. Everything men use to build, God made!!

APPLICATION:

- → God's infinity:
- 1. Magnifies Grace! God is SO FAR ABOVE AND BEYOND US! But indeed He did come down to undeserving, sinful mankind!
- 2. Highlights the Incarnation!! God did come to dwell on earth—the INFINITE with the weak, poor, beggarly of this world.
- 3. Shames IDOLATRY! IDOLATRY IS AN INSULT TO GOD!! Human depravity tries to PUT GOD IN A BOX, a mold, a structure made with hands!
