# Bible Study Questions/ Discussion "The Persecution of Faith" Hebrews 11:35-40 March 4, 2012

- 1. Discuss any levels of persecution you have felt in your life as you follow Christ. What confidence does Jesus give to us concerning our battle with the enemy? (Matt. 16:18) Review what the New Testament teaches about suffering persecution.

- 2. Describe the mocking and mistreatment Jesus received. (Matt. 26:67; 27:29) God's people will be laughed at by the world. (Jer. 20:7; Jude 18; 2 Chron. 36:16) Share a time when you observed Christians being laughed at. How did the Christians respond?
- 3. Taking a stand for Christ can cost you financially. What kind of financial impact (loss of income) can happen in the U.S.A. if you refuse to compromise?
- 4. Review Heb. 11:36-38 and discuss the impact on the living situation for some followers of Christ. (Also I Kings 18:4) Martyrdom is real possibility for over 50 nations in the world today. What did Jesus say in Matt. 23:37? (Also 2 Chron. 24:21; I Kings 19:10)
- 5. What is the attitude of a Christ follower facing persecution? (Rev. 12:11) Where is their strength?
