### 1897- NIV- 1 Peter 2:9 YOUR IDENTITY!

We live in an age when some people do **not know** their **identity** - who M & D are! Others are fussy about their **identity!** I introduced someone who was **upset** at being referred to as the **successor** to their well-known predecessor! Or the son/daughter of someone well-known person! Introducers are but trying to give the individual an **identity**, but the individual wanted **his own identity!** People **do** want to be perceived as who **THEY feel** and **think** they are! **Bad basis!** 

Many want to **MAKE** their **own identity!** However, what is **important** is not who **we** think we are, but who **GOD** thinks we are! Who does **He** think we are! You may think/believe you are someone, whom you are not! But **God** gets it right every time! Here, we have **God** giving His people their identity - whatever they may think of themselves, they are whom God says they are! But.....

#### WE OUGHT BE CERTAIN ABOUT OUR IDENTITY

**Listen** to God's Son re His identity: *I know* where *I came from and* where *I am going* [John 8:14]. Listen to the **Psalmist** we are the people of **His** pasture, the flock under **His** care [Psa 95:7]. Listen to Paul say about himself and the Roman Xns we are God's children and whether we live or whether we die, we belong to the Lord [Rom 8:16+14:8] Paul also said to the Phil we who are the circumcision... who worship by the Spirit of God [Phil 3:3]!

In **prayer**, the OT Church was able to say <u>Doubtless</u> You are our Father, Though Abraham was ignorant of us, And Israel does not acknowledge us. You, O LORD, are our Father; Our Redeemer [Isa 63:16 NJKV]! God's people ought to be able to identify themselves as His children! We ought constantly to be able to give thanks to God for His covenant love to us! Especially at communion time!!

Yet, it seems this is the very point Peter is trying to make here. He is **contrasting** his readers with those who have **stumbled over Christ** - trying to **assure** the **God's elect** [1:1], no less, who they are **you are** a **chosen people** - make no mistake about it, you are **special**, that is, special in **God's eyes** – you may not be special to anybody else, but

you are very special to God! APP If someone asked you Xn brother/ sister 'Who are you?', what would you say? Would you say, 'I belong to God? He has **chosen** me as His **special treasure'?** If you are a believer, and you did not reply like that, God would be disappointed with you! Just as a parent would be disappointed at his child not owning him or her as father or mother, God would 'behurt' for He is **tender-hearted** – especially regarding His own. He even calls sinners saved by grace, the *apple of His eye*! [Zech 2:8]!

### The CONTEXT

The previous verses to our text, talk about the **central figure in all of life** – Jesus Christ! They depict Him as **either** a **blessing** or a **curse** to humanity! Christ is either the **capstone** of people's lives (the main 'holding-together' piece) or He is a Stone/Rock that **causes** people to **stumble**, *a rock that makes them fall* [8b]! **APP** X is either a **blessing** or a **curse** to you! He either **makes** you or **breaks** you? He either keeps your life together, or He breaks you down!

We are **constantly confronted** with Jesus in our lives! We meet Him at every turn – His Word challenges us 24/7 - in every crisis, in every situation! Jesus perpetually reminds us of the **moral** and **spiritual** aspect of life - and calls us to **duty**- to do the **right** things every time!

Jesus, actually gives us **identity!** Our **relationship** to Jesus Christ **defines** us! He gives us our real **personality.** It is *In Him* we have redemption...forgiveness...the riches of God's grace [Eph1] Paul's desire was to be found in Him [Phi 3:9 John: abide in Him [1J2:28]

APP Our Government believes that the best way to stop evil (terrorism, drugs, child-abuse) is to issue Identity Cards! But the best way, and by far the cheapest way to stop evil, is to convert people to Christ!! It is Christ that gives us identity – it is X that makes us better people. In fact we are so much better 'in Christ', the Bible calls us new creatures! The Government's Identity Cards is to list all your offences and examine your past life and loyalty to the State – it is really to see are you worthy of a good and clean Identity Card! Contrast X's Identity Card - it is to assure you that you have been chosen by God DESPITE your past life and sins!

The context here talks of Jesus Christ being the One Special Chosen Person who is precious to God. And that those who believe in Him (ie, are **identified** with Him) will never be put to shame [6] There are those of course who do not believe in Him they disobey the Word ESV [8] Peter makes the point that some believe and some do not!

# **BEING CHOSEN**

But it is **not** just the **One** *living Stone* that has been chosen! Peter says there is a whole 'race, nation, generation' who have been chosen. Peter here talks about **people** being **chosen** as well. He gives an **illustration** from his time. In Peter's day, builders had to **choose** stones from among a **pile! Unlike** today's builders where each brick/block is **pre-cut** to a certain size, and all are the **same**, builders then, had to **select** the one **suitable** for the **particular place** it would occupy in the building. Peter is illustrating how Christ is like a capstone, which exactly fits and **unites** all the other stones together and becomes the **central** stone in building. Take it away and it falls!

Peter (God), is saying that it is the same with people who believe — they have been chosen by God because they are precious to God! ...you [plural] are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God (you belong to Him!). How wonderful! Peter is reminding/assuring them and us, it is no accident that you believe in Him — because you were chosen.

Yes, **chosen to believe!** The Scriptures mention this matter of being chosen or elected a lot, because there is a **tendency** to **pride** – even among God's people in the matter of being a Xn! The Bible makes abundantly clear, there is no room for boasting of any kind in God's kingdom! What do you have that you did **not receive?** If then you received it, why do you boast **as if** you did not receive it? [1Cor 4:7]

# **GOD'S PERCEPTION of His CHOSEN**

Peter is writing to **encourage** and assure his readers who are being **persecuted** for their faith, that they **are really special** in **God**'s eyes. God sees them as *a royal priesthood*! Royalty and priesthood are at the **top** of the human ladder in **every culture.** It is **God's Word** that

calls Xns royal priests. Christ has made us a kingdom, priests to His God and Father [Rev 1:6]! Whatever you feel, God sees you as kings/priests, possessing a special dignity as far as He is concerned!

Royalty have a **special honour**! *the honour* is for you who believe! **[ESV 2:7]** It is a great honour to be a believer! God is honouring all those who believe in Him. We ought to recognise that honour!

You are a *a holy nation*. Not just **individuals**, you are **united** group of believers. **Individualistic** Xnity is an **absurdity** – Xnity is a **community**, a **fellowship**. Xns are *being joined together...and built together to become a dwelling in which God lives* [Eph 2:20-22] Rick Warren= "put together, joined together, built together, members together, heirs together, fitted together, held together, and will be caught up together"!

What other 'Club' **stipulates** the condition of **membership** to include this: that we **love** each other, **pray** for each other, **encourage** each other, **admonish** each other, **welcome** each other, **serve** each other, **teach** each other, **accept** each other, **honour** each other, **carry** each other's burdens, **forgive** each other, **submit** to each other, be **devoted** to each other – and spend **eternity together**? No Sport's Club or Health Club!! Do you realize that **real maturity** shows up in **relationships** – not individualism! Indivd. product of Enlightenment!

Today, many people in our culture, do **not** feel a sense of **belonging** – they feel isolated. Many feel an **'emptiness'** – they are of no purpose or value. This is due to the teaching that we are not created by God for a purpose. The bottom line is, they have **no identity!** 

Chosen for what purpose? To declare the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His wonderful light You/I are to commend God. Your whole life is to be a testimony to God's goodness. People are to 'learn' from you that God is wonderful. They ought to get the impression, after being with you/I, that there is no one as good as God! All the heroes in [Heb 11] by their lives of faith declare plainly that God is a wonderful God – He is worth dying for! \*We have the opportunity tomorrow to declare His praises by remembering His death! As often as you...shew the Lord's death
