

Choose This Day Whom You Will Serve! Matthew 7:13-20

- 1) There are only two paths to choose (7:13-14)
 - a) The narrow gate leads to eternal life
 - i) A small gate, or "door" (cf. John 10:7, 9)
 - ii) Few go through this gate (Rev. 7:9; cf. 19:1, 6)
 - b) The broad gate that leads to eternal destruction (cf. 2 Thess. 1:9)
 - i) A wide path of legalism and liberalism
 - ii) Many enter through this gate
 - c) There is no neutral gate
- 2) There are prophets and preachers advocating for both paths (7:15-20)
 - a) Beware of false prophets (cf. 1 John 4:1)
 - i) Wolves that dress like sheep
 - ii) They fail to preach God's Word
 - iii) Their character will expose them
 - iv) They will eventually be burned like firewood
 - b) Look for true prophets
 - i) They preach God's Word accurately
 - ii) They live consistently with what they preach
 - iii) They boldly call sinners to repentance
 - iv) Those they teach are gentle, humble, and pious
- 3) Whom will you serve?
 - a) Choose life and blessings (Deut 30:19; Josh 24:15)
 - b) Strive to enter! (Luke 13:24)
 - c) Christ is the only way (John 14:6; cf. Acts 4:12)
 - d) Take up your cross, follow Christ daily (Mark 8:34)
 - e) Love God with everything you have (Deut. 6:4-5)
