For this reason I, Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus for you, the Gentiles – ² assuming that you heard of the stewardship, which is the grace of God given to me for you, ³ that by revelation the mystery was made known to me (just as I wrote before in brief), ⁴ respecting which you are able, while reading, to perceive my comprehension in the mystery of Christ, ⁵ which in other generations was not made known to the sons of men, as now it has been revealed to His holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit,

⁶ that the Gentiles are co-inheritors and co-body-members and copartakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the good news, ⁷ of which I was made a servant by virtue of the gift, which is the grace of God given to me by virtue of the working ¹ of His power. ⁸ To me, less than the least ² of all holy ones, was this grace given: to tell the good news of the untrackable wealth of Christ, ⁹ and to enlighten all *as to* what is the stewardship of the mystery which has been hidden away from the ages in God, who created all things,...
