## **Grace Beyond the Barriers**

Acts 10:1-33 Acts: The Real Church Pastor Phil Winfield March 6, 2016

God's grace calls us to go beyond the **barriers** of prejudice and beyond the **borders** of race.

- 1. God extends his grace to **sincere seekers** (10:1-8)
  - a. A sincere seeker **<u>responds</u>** to the light he is given.
  - *b.* A sincere seeking **<u>sinner</u>** will be found by the seeking **<u>Savior</u>**.
  - c. A sincere seeker understands that his religion **is not enough**.
- God extends his grace through believers who cross the prejudice barrier (v.9-23).
  - a. Prejudice is deeply rooted
  - b. **<u>Obedience</u>** eliminates the prejudice barrier
- 3. God extends his grace through *circles of influence* (v.24-33).
  - a. When we meet with seekers we meet on common ground
  - b. When we meet with one it may open the door **to many**!
  - c. When we meet with seeking sinners <u>**God**</u> is at work!

Let's take this with us:

- No one is **<u>beyond</u>** God's grace.
- We are not free to set up or maintain <u>barriers</u> of <u>prejudice</u> that keep us from contact with people.
- God is working behind the scenes in all the **<u>encounters</u>** if our lives.
- We must get up and **<u>obediently go</u>** to the people of our lives.
- **<u>Religion</u>** is not enough; it takes a <u>**relationship**</u> to be saved.
