1. TURN AWAY FROM FALSE SAVIORS / SALVATION
2. TURN TOWARDS THE LORD — “GOD ALONE”

1. THE WRONG WAY
2. THE RIGHT WAY (“TURN & LOOK”)
◇ NUMBERS 21, THE BRONZE SERPENT
3. ONE WAY FOR ALL
4. ONE DAY TO DECIDE (“TODAY”)

C. WHAT DOES SALVATION BRING?

1. CERTAINTY OF DELIVERANCE
2. NOT NECESSARILY EASE OF CIRCUMSTANCES
3. CLEAR HOPE FOR THE NATIONS
