"We Have This Treasure!" 2 Corinthians 4:7-12

Introduction:

- IE: Have You Ever Known Someone Who Received A Windfall Of Some Kind? Perhaps Someone Who Was Given An Unexpected Gift Of Money – Or Someone Who Received A Large Inheritance – Or Even Someone Who Won The Lottery? This Doesn't Happen Too Often – But When It Does – It Can Change People! And Not Necessarily In A Good Way! In A Moment, A Person Who Was Poor Is Now Rich! A Person Who Had Nothing Now Feels Like He Can Have Everything! Hear Stories Like This And Think - I Wish That Would Happen To Me! Might Want To Think Again! Don McNay, A Financial Consultant Who Has Assisted Many Winners Of The Powerball Lottery Discovered That - "So many of them wind up unhappy or wind up broke. People have had terrible things happen! People commit suicide. People run though their money. Easy comes, easy goes. They go through divorce or people die. It's just upheaval that they're not ready for!" Money & Wealth Can Change People's Lives – Sometimes For The Better – Many Times For The Worse!

- We Are Going To Head Back To:

- 2 Corinthians 4 - Where We Have Been Exploring:

- The Glory Of The Gospel Together:

- Over The Last Several Weeks!

- And When We Come To 4:7:

- We Find That Every Christian:

- Has Been Given A Special Kind Of Windfall!

- A Spiritual Windfall!

- Even Greater Than A Gift Or An Inheritance Or A Lottery Winning That Can

Come Easily & Go Just As Easily!

- In The Words Of 4:7 "We Have This Treasure!"
 - We Have A Treasure!

- Now Just:

- What Is This Treasure?

- That Paul Is Talking About?

- It Is The Treasure Of The Gospel!
 - In 4:7 Paul Is Pointing Back To 4:6 Where He Describes The Gospel As:
 - "The Light Of The Knowledge Of The Glory Of God In The Face Of Jesus

Christ!"

- When You "Believe On The Lord Jesus Christ!"

- You Receive This Great Treasure!

- And It Includes:

- The Light Of God's Wisdom:

- And His Knowledge!

- You Can Now Know God!
- The Light Of God's Wonder:

- And His Glory!

- You Can Now Worship Him!

- And The Light Of God's Way:

- Which Is Jesus Christ!

- You Can Trust Him & One Day See Him Face To Face!

- And So - When You Are Saved:

- You Are Wealthier Than The Wealthiest Person In All Of The World!

- 2 Corinthians 8:9 - "For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was

rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich!"

- You Are Rich!

- With The Treasure Of The Gospel!

- You Are Rich:

- With The Treasure Of Jesus Christ Himself!

- "We Have This Treasure!"

- But - Where Is This Treasure?

- That Paul Is Talking About?

- Continues In 4:7 - "But We Have This Treasure – The Gospel – In Earthen Vessels!"

- IE: If You Had A Treasure Of Money - What Would You Do With It? Most - Put It In The Safest Place Possible! Save It - In The Bank! Invest It - To Make Something Off Of It! Client Once Told Me - Had Over \$100,000 In Tucked Away In The Walls Of Her House! Not The Wisest / Safest Place!

- But Look Where God Has Placed The Treasure Of His Gospel:

- "In Earthen Vessels!"

- In Clay Pots & Jars!

- We Might Think - Is That The Wisest & Safest Place To Put Something As Valuable & Precious As The Gospel?

- But The Truth Is - Paul Is Describing:

- You & Me! We Are These "Earthen Vessels!"

- Even As Isaiah Described Us In Isaiah 64:8 - "But now, O LORD, thou art our father;

we are the clay, and thou our potter; and we all are the work of thy hand!"

- But Like A Pot Or Vase Made Out Of Clay - We Are Frail & Fragile & Easily Broken!

- So - Why Would God Do This? God Gave Us His Treasure:

- Not Because He Needed Us:

- To Safeguard It - Like A Safe Made Out Of Iron!

- But Because We Needed It:

- To Safeguard Us - Because We Are:

- "Earthen Vessels!"

- "Jars Of Clay!"

- And - Why Did God Give Us This Treasure?

- The Treasure Of His Gospel & His Light?

- To Change Us!

- To Change Us - By His Power:

- And In The Best Way Possible!

3. Remember - Wealth Can Change People!

- Maybe Not Their Nature:

- But It Can Change Their Circumstances!

- But The Treasure Of The Gospel:

- Has Been Given To You - A Plain / Simple "Earthen Vessels" To Change You Entirely! - From The Inside Out!

- And The Rest Of Our Passage Reveals:

- The Kind Of Change:

- That "This Treasure" Can Bring To You & Me!

- The Treasure Of The Gospel Will Change How You Will Approach Your Life & Even Your Death!

* First - The Treasure Of The Gospel Will:

1. Change The Purpose Of Your Life!

- See This In The Rest Of 4:7:

- "But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us!"

- Why Did God Give You Such A Great Treasure?

- So That He Might Be Glorified:

- And Lifted Up - In Your Life & In The Lives Of Others!

- The "Power" That Is Mentioned Here:

- Seems To Refer To The Power & Influence That A Treasure & Wealth Can Bring!

- Money Can Open Doors That Normally Would Be Closed!

- IE: Politicians - Fund Raising Dinners - Sometimes Thousands Of Dollars -

For A Chance To See & Speak With Them!

- But Its One Thing:

- When It Is Your Money!

- But If Someone Gave You The Money Or Made The Donation For You:

- It Does Not Reflect On You - But On Your Benefactor!

- And That's What The Power Of Our Treasure Does As Well!

- It Does Not Reflect:

- On Me & My Ability!

- Because I'm Just A Jar Made Out Of Clay!

- 1 Corinthians 1:26-29 - Paul Reminds Us - "For ye see your calling, brethren, how that not many wise men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called: / But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty; / And base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are: / That no flesh should glory in his presence!"

- We Are Simple "Earthen Vessels!"

- Instead - Any Power We Have From The Treasure Of The Gospel Reflects:

- On The Lord!

- His Grace To Us & His Glory In Us!

- And So - The Treasure Of The Gospel:

- Will Change The Purpose Of Your Life!

- To Glorify The Lord:

- Because Of All That He Has Done For You & Has Given You!

- 1 Peter 4:11 - "If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God; if any man minister, let him do it as of the ability which God giveth: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. Amen!"

- Is This Your Purpose?

- The Purpose Of Your Life?

To "Glorify God In Your Body And In Your Spirit, Which Are God's!" (1 Corinthians 6:20)
 This Is The Change That God's Treasure Will Bring!

* Second - The Treasure Of The Gospel Will:

2. Change The Pattern Of Your Life!

- See This In 4:8-9:

- "We are troubled on every side, yet not distressed; we are perplexed, but not in despair; / Persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed!"

- These Verses First Describe What Life Is Like:

- As An "Earthen Vessel!"

- When You Are A Christian, You Will Continue To Experience These Kinds Of Circumstances!

- You Will Experience:

- Pressure In Life! (4:8)

- Because You Will Be "Troubled On Every Side!"

- Physical Pressure / Mental / Social / Spiritual / In Every Way Imaginable!

- You Will Experience:

- Perplexities In Life! (4:8)

- Doubt & Anxiety - About Decisions & Dilemmas!

- You Will Experience:

- Persecution In Life! (4:9)

- To Persecute Here Means To Be Chased & Pursued - With The Intent To Harm You! - This Can Happen To All People, But Especially Christians!

- You Will Experience:

- Pain In Life! (4:9)

- "Cast Down" Is Like The "Take Down" In A Wrestling Match! Can Be Painful!

- This Is The Pattern Of Your Life:

- If You Are A Christian!

- After All - It Was The Pattern Of Jesus' Life!

- A Pattern Of Suffering!

- Pressures / Perplexities / Persecution / Pain!

- Not Always Physical - But Spiritual!

- 1 Peter 5:8 - "Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour!" - He Is Always Pursuing! And When He Does:

- He Will Bring Pressure!

- Through Temptation & Trials!

- He Will Bring Perplexity! - To Create Doubt! Always Has / Will! - He Will Seek To Bring Pain! - To "Devour!" - With All This Going On - John Gill - "It Is Surprising That Earthen Vessels Should Bear And Suffer So Much. And Not Fall. Or Be Dashed To Pieces!" - But - Because You Have "This Treasure" Of The Gospel: - And The Light Of: - God's Wisdom / Wonder / Way! - It Changes The Pattern Of Your Life! - It Breaks The Pattern Of Your Life! How? - Key Words In 4:8-9 - "Yet Not / But Not!" - Because Of The Power Of The Gospel: - And The Power Of Christ In Your Life: - You May Be: - "Troubled On Every Side, Yet Not Distressed!" (4:8) - Because Jesus Gives You Hope! - You May Be: - "Perplexed, But Not In Despair!" (4:8) - Because Jesus Gives You Wisdom & Understanding! - You May Be: - "Persecuted, But Not Forsaken!" (4:9) - Because Jesus Is With You! Hebrews 13:5 - "For he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee!" - You May Be: - "Cast Down, But Not Destroyed!" (4:9) - Because Jesus Has Saved Your Soul, And You Are Forever Safe In The Arms Of Jesus! John 10:28-29 - "And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. / My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand!" - This Is What Makes The Power Of God & His Gospel: - So Great & So Excellent! - He Gives You Hope & He Gives You Help! - No Matter What Kind Of Obstacle Or Opposition You Face In Your Life! - And So - When The Pattern Of Struggles: - And Suffering In Life: - Wears On You - And All Seems Dark & Dim - Reopen The Treasure Chest Of the Gospel! - And Look To The Gleaming Light Of The Treasure God Has Given You! - Because The Light Of His Wisdom / His Wonder / His Way: - Will Lead You Through The Darkness: - So That You Can Continue To Glorify Him! * Third - The Treasure Of The Gospel Will: **Change The Perspective Of Your Life!** - See This In 4:10-11: - "Always bearing about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our body. / For we which live are alway delivered unto death for Jesus' sake, that the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our mortal flesh!" - In These Verses - Paul Describes For Us: - What Is Really Going On: - When You Experience The Pattern Of Life's Pressures / Perplexities / Persecutions / Pain!

- What Is Really Going On:

- In The Life Of A Christian?

- Through It All:

- You Are Suffering With Jesus:

- And You Are Serving Jesus!

- And This Will Completely Change Your Perspective When You Are Experiencing Suffering & Struggles As A Christian!

- Through It All:

- You Are A Participant:

- In The Death Of Jesus!

- 4:10 Like Paul You Are "Always Bearing About In The Body The Dying Of The Lord Jesus!"
 And The Reason For This Paul Gives In 4:11 "For we which live are alway delivered unto death for Jesus' sake!"
 - This Means That You Are Going Through The Process Of Death!
- And Paul Knew Painfully Well What It Meant To Suffer For Jesus!
 - Galatians 6:17 "I bear in my body the marks of the Lord Jesus!"
 - And So Like Paul & Like Jesus You Are Going Through The Experience Of Suffering That Will Ultimately Lead To Death!
- But A Christian Dies Differently:
 - Than A Non-Christian!
 - As You Die / When You Die / You Now Do So In Fellowship With The Sufferings Of Christ!
- Wasn't This Paul's Desire In Philippians 3:10 "That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death!"
- And The Treasure Of Christ & His Gospel Will Change Your Perspective:
 - On Suffering & Death! Also:
- You Are A Proof:

- Of The Life Of Jesus!

- 4:10-11 - "Always bearing about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, *that* the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our body. / For we which live are alway delivered unto death for Jesus' sake, *that* the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our mortal flesh!"

- When You Are A Christian: The Way You Suffer & The Way You Struggle:
 - Will Be The Proof & Evidence That Jesus Himself Is Alive!

- When You Suffer - When You Struggle - When You Sorrow:

- You Have Hope In Jesus Christ!
 - John 14:19 "Because I live, ye shall live also!"
- And The Treasure Of Christ & His Gospel Will Change Your Perspective On Life!
 - Galatians 2:20 "I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me!"
- Do You Have This Kind Of Perspective?
 - About Your Own Death?
 - About Your Own Life?

 - 4:12 "So then death worketh in us, but life in you!"

 - It Changed The Pattern Of His Life!
 - It Changed The Perspective Of His Life!
 - And So Death Had Lost Its Sting For Paul!
 - And He Was Content To Go Through:
 - All The Suffering & All The Struggles:
 - That Accompany Death!
 - Because He Had "This Treasure The Treasure Of Christ / The Treasure Of The Gospel In His Earthen Vessel!"
 - But He Was Also Content:
 - Because He Knew That God Was Using:
 - Him As Frail & As Fragile As He Was:
 - To Bring Life To Others!
