## "SAVING OUR CHILDREN" EPHESIANS 5:18-6:4 "LIVING A SHARED LIFE"

- I. ...BUT BE COMPLETED BY THE SPIRIT
  - A. Who governs your life? Who do you serve?
    - 1. Yourself?
    - 2. God?
    - 3. Some other?
  - B. What is the purpose of your life? What is your mission? Purpose determines mission
  - C. Living for the short term or the long term? Producing fruit or bearing fruit?
  - D. God's purpose, plan, mission and power for you!
    - 1. To conform you to the image of His Son
    - 2. To sanctify for and train you as a leader in the world to come
    - 3. To make you fruitful in your leadership training
    - 4. All this being done through sharing the life of Christ by the Holy Spirit
    - 5. This shared life is the only acceptable service given to the Lord. Bearing not producing.
      - a. Everything else is a <u>loss</u>.
      - b. It may have gratified you so you have your <u>reward</u>. Expect nothing else
      - c. It may have benefited someone else so you have your reward. A servant is not rewarded for doing what he was <u>told</u>.
  - E. Be completed by the Holy Spirit how to be filled with the Spirit Eph 5:18-21

# *"BEING A RESTORED HUMAN"*



- 1. Live your identity and actually trusting Christ
- 2. Intentionally know the words of Christ as the total truth; the perfect reality; not common words or pithy sayings
- 3. "Filling" is actually "being fulfilled" or completed by the Spirit
  - a. Take a faith-filled, expectant, step of obedience
  - b. The Spirit interacts with your spirit to complete that action as godly
  - c. This shared action opens your spirit to further evidences of being a child of God
    - 1c. <u>Answered</u> prayer John 15:7
    - 2c. <u>Transformed</u> thinking Rom 12:2
    - 3c. Desire for more opportunities to glorify Christ; boldness Acts 4:23ff
    - 4c. <u>Unbridled</u> praise of God Eph 5:19
    - 5c. Powerful thanksgiving Eph 5:20
    - 6c. <u>Humility</u> overflowing into mutual <u>submission</u> to one another Eph 5:21 See also 1 Pet 5:1-9 Submission to one another wrapped in humility; receiving God's grace; not being resisted by Him
- 4. Applications of submitting to one another bring restoration to the family as God intended it
  - a. Wives submit to your husbands is the evidence of a Spirit-filled wife
    - 1a. Reversing the curse
    - 2a. Restoring team work with dignity
