
## The Feasts of the Lord

2. The Passover	
The 14 <sup>th</sup> day of the first month	1 Corinthians 5:7
It is holy day commemorating God's deliverance	
of Israel from bondage to Egypt.	
3. The Feast of Unleavened Bread	
The 15 <sup>th</sup> day of the first month and lasting for 7 days	Hebrews 4:15
A week of meal offerings to the Lord.	
4. The Feast of Firstfruits	
The 22 <sup>nd</sup> day of the first month	1 Corinthians 15:20-23
Thanking God for the first fruits expresses faith in God	
to continue to bless the whole season to the last of the harves	t.
5. The Feast of Weeks (Pentacost)	
The 50 <sup>th</sup> day from the last Sabbath of Passover.	John 16:7
Celebration of a great harvest.	
FALL	
6. The Feast of Trumpets	
The 1 <sup>st</sup> day of the seventh month	1 Corinthians 15:52
It is generally referred to as a time	
of repentance and regathering.	
7. The Day of Atonement	
The 10th day of the seventh month	Revelation 1:7
A day of corporate repentance.	
8. The Feast of Booths	
The 15 <sup>th</sup> day of the seventh month and lasting for 7 days	Micah 4:1-5
it was a memorial in the booths to	
the wandering of Israel for forty years.
