A Legacy of Blessing

Hebrews 11:17-23

- I. <u>ABRAHAM'S FAITH</u> (17-19; Gen 22:1-18)—*instructed his children*
 - **A.** Pursued God Above All Things (Mat 10:21-22, 37-38)—tested for idolatry
 - 1. Only God is worthy of such devotion!
 - 2. God IS worthy.
 - B. <u>Informed His Understanding</u> (19)—employed holy reasoning
 - **1. God's Word**—I know what God promised.
 - 2. God's Character (1 Tim 1:12)—I know God is faithful,
 - **3. God's Power** (Mat 22:29)—I know that nothing is impossible for God
 - C. Compelled Complete Obedience—extreme, ultimate, unquestioning
 - **D.** <u>Believed in Resurrection</u> (Heb11:9-10; 39-40; Lk 1:47; 1 Thes 5:10)— This is the essential bit of supernatural information that undergirds our faith.
 - 1. There is more than a mechanistic universe in a closed system.
 - 2. God is not limited by what we consider to be possible.
 - 3. God's promise is for me, but not just for me in my lifetime.
- II. ISAAC'S FAITH (20; Gen 25-27)—invoked blessing on his children,
 - **A.** Our faith is able to bless our children. (Gen 18:19; Deut 11:18-21; Pro 14:26; 1 Cor 7:14)
 - 1. God blesses the children of a believer. (1 Cor 7:14; Act 2:39)

2. The blessing contains an <u>obligation</u> to follow the LORD. (Gen 18:19)

- **3. Parents must instruct and disciple their children in the faith.** (Deut 11:18-21; Ps 34:11; Eph 6:4). —The blessing is not *automatically* transmitted; it requires faith, must be pursued.
- **B.** Our faith is demonstrated in the way we raise our children. (There is a God and you are not Him!)
 - 1. God uses imperfect parents.
 - 2. We worship God because *He* is worthy, not because we are.
- III. JACOB'S FAITH (21; Gen 28-35, 48-49)—a legacy of blessing
 - A. The Blessing of a Godly Heritage—our faith will affect generations
 - 1. The God of Our Fathers—the source of our blessing
 - **2.** The History of Our People (Gen 32:24-28)—a connection to something bigger
 - a. Our witness includes honesty about our own struggles with God. (Gen 32:24-28; Ps 78)
 - b. We have a duty to our ancestors and to our posterity.
 - 3. The Holiness of Our Calling—our identity and purpose
 - B. The Witness of a Believer's Death.—worshipped God at his death
- IV. JOSEPH'S FAITH (22; Gen 50:22-26)—reminds us of the future
 - **A.** <u>Made Mention of the Exodus</u> —reminded the next generation of God's promise
 - **B.** <u>Gave Directions Concerning His Bones</u>—memorial of expectant faith...
