QUESTION # 136: WHAT ARE THE SINS FORBIDDEN IN THE SIXTH COMMANDMENT?

ANSWER:

THE SINS FORBIDDEN IN THE SIXTH COMMANDMENT ARE, ALL TAKING AWAY THE LIFE OF OURSELVES,^A OR OF OTHERS,^B EXCEPT IN CASE OF PUBLIC JUSTICE,^C LAWFUL WAR,^D OR NECESSARY DEFENSE;^E THE NEGLECTING OR WITHDRAWING THE LAWFUL AND NECESSARY MEANS OF PRESERVATION OF LIFE;^F SINFUL ANGER,^G HATRED,^H ENVY,^I DESIRE OF REVENGE;^J ALL EXCESSIVE PASSIONS,^K DISTRACTING CARES;^L IMMEDIATE USE OF MEAT, DRINK,^M LABOUR,^N AND RECREATIONS;^O PROVOKING WORDS,^P OPPRESSION,^Q QUARRELING,^R STRIKING, WOUNDING,^S AND WHATSOEVER ELSE TENDS TO THE DESTRUCTION OF THE LIFE OF ANY.^T
