- A. Greatness in the kingdom is described as a life of conversion, a daily life of turning from sin and to obeying God. When we do this, we are like a little child.
- B. Jesus addresses a serious sin from which we must be converted: pride.
- C. Jesus calls us to humility when He calls us to become as little children (vs. 3, 4).
- II. Learning How we learn about the greatness of humility from our children.
  - A. Looking at our children cuts down our sinful pride because the basis of what Jesus says is that children are included in the kingdom, covenant, and church of God.
  - B. We learn this humility from the example of our children in two ways.
    - 1. Young children do not view themselves as better than others.
    - 2. Children trust the Word of God when instructed.
  - C. There is a higher example from whom we learn Jesus Christ.
