4. **The Pictures Of Prophecy:**

- Which Means That:

- "Old Testament Prophecy, Especially When Dealing With Eschatological Themes, Is Often Typical Or Typological In Nature!"

- This Is Related To The Symbolic Language That We Find In Prophecy:

- But - Types In The Bible Are More For *Illustration* Than Explanation!

- So - What Is A Biblical "Type"?

- "A type is a real person, place, object, or event that God ordained to act as a predictive pattern or resemblance of Jesus' person and work!" (David Murray - "Jesus On Every Page")

- "Typology Is Visual Theology" (David Murray)

- In Romans 5:14 - The Apostle Paul:

- Highlights This Principle:

- In The Relationship Between Adam & Jesus Christ:

- "Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over them that had not sinned

after the similitude of Adam's transgression, who is the *figure* of him that was to come!"

- "Figure" - τύπος / Type

- So - There Are Many Different Kinds:

- Of Types In The Bible:

- Including:

- People, Institutions, And/Or Events:

- Which - "Prefigures Or Foreshadows A New And <u>Greater</u> Reality!" - Which Is Known As:

- The "Antitype!"

- Paul Uses This Principle Also:

- In Colossians 2:16-17 - "Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days: / Which are a shadow of things to come; but the body is of Christ!"

- This Means That The Special Days That The Old Testament People Of God Were To Consecrate & Celebrate Were "Object Lessons" That Point To Their Ultimate Fulfillment In Jesus!

- Sabbath - Rest On A Day - Points To & Is Fulfilled In - Rest In Christ!

- We See This Also:

- In The Sacrifices Of The Old Testament!

- From: "Old Testament Sacrifices' Fulfillment in Christ" (Isaac Khalil - lifehopeandtruth.com) - Burnt Offering (Leviticus 1:3-17; 6:8-13):

- Completely Burned Up On The Altar

- Sweet Aroma To God
- Unblemished Animal
- Symbol Of The Atonement:

- Provided Through Christ - Perfect & Pure & Willing To Give Himself For Us!

- Romans 5:11 - "But we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the atonement!"

- Grain Offering (Leviticus 2:1-16; 6:14-23):

- Accompanied All Burnt Offerings

- Sweet Aroma To God

- Flour / Oil / Frankincense / Salt

- Symbol Of Dedication / Consecration:

- Provided Through Christ - In Whom His Father Was "Well Pleased!"

- John 10:17-18a - "Therefore doth my Father love me, because I lay down my life, that I might take it again. / No man taketh it from me, but I lay it down of myself!"

- Peace Offering (Leviticus 3:1-17; 7:11-34):

- Sweet Aroma To God

- Provided A Meal For Priests / People
- Three Kinds Thanksgiving / Vow / Voluntary (Free Will)
- Symbol Of Reconciliation / Fellowship:

- Provided Through Christ - "He Is Our Peace" (Ephesians 2:14) - He Is Our

Reconciliation!

- Sin Offering (Leviticus 4:1-35; 6:24-30):

- Generally Not A Sweet Aroma To God

- Only The Fat & Blood Offered On The Altar

- When The Sin Offering Is For The Whole Congregation, The Rest Was Burned Outside The Camp

- Symbol Of Propitiation:

- Provided Through Christ - The One Who Satisfied The Wrath Of God Completely For The Sins Of Those Who Believe In Him!

- 1 John 2:2 - "And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world!"

- Sufficient For All! Efficient For Believers!

- Hebrews 13:12 - "Wherefore Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people with his own blood,

suffered without the gate!"

- Trespass Offering (Leviticus 5:14–6:7; 7:1-7):

- Like The Sin Offering

- Dealt With Specific Sins & Where Restitution Was Possible

- Symbol Of Forgiveness:

- Provided Though Christ - For Every Sin!

- 1 John 1:9 - "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us [our] sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness!"

- So - These Were All Types & Shadows:

- Of The Final Sacrifice:

- Of Jesus Christ:

- When He Shed His Blood On The Cross!

- We See This Also:

- In The *Tabernacle* & Temple Of The Old Testament:

- Which Were Also Types & Shadows:

- Of The Final Dwelling-Place & Meeting-Place:

- Of God With Man:

- Jesus Christ!

- The Furnishings Of The Tabernacle:

- The Door:

- John 10:9 - "I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture!"

- The Altar:

- John 1:29 - "The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world!"

- The Laver:

- John 7:38 - "He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water!"

- The Table Of Shewbread:

- John 6:35 - "And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst!"

- The Lampstand / Menorah:

- John 8:12 - "Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life!"

- The Altar Of Incense - A Symbol For Prayer:

- Hebrews 7:25 - "Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them!"

- The Ark Of The Covenant & The Mercy Seat:

- John 1:14 - "And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth!"

- And - All Of This Helps Us Remember:

- That The Fulfilment - The Antitype:

- Is Always Greater Than:

- The Type & The Shadow:

- That Pointed To It!

- And So - We Need To Think:

In Terms Of Types As Well:
When We Come To Prophecies About The End Times!
A Fifth Principle Of Prophecy Has To Do With:

- The Ultimate Fulfillment Of All Prophecy: - Will Be Related To:

- Not Only Is He:

- The Center Of The Bible:

- The Focus Of Prophecy:

- Is Primarily:

- So - Even When We Come To Old Testament Prophecies:

- We Can Now Look At Them Through The Lense Of The New

Testament!

- The Apostle Paul Puts It This Way:

- 2 Corinthians 3:12-16 - "Seeing then that we have such hope, we use great plainness of speech: / And not as Moses, which put a vail over his face, that the children of Israel could not stedfastly look to the end of that which is abolished: / But their minds were blinded: for until this day remaineth the same vail untaken away in the reading of the old testament; which <u>vail</u> is done away in Christ!"

- Charles Hodge - "The Old Testament Scriptures are intelligible only when understood as predicting and prefiguring Christ. The knowledge of Christ, as a matter of fact and as a matter of course, removes the veil from the Old Testament. The main idea of the whole context is, that the recognition of Jesus Christ as Lord, or Jehovah, is the key to the Old Testament. It opens all its mysteries, or, to use the figure of the apostle, it removes the veil that hid from the Jews the true meaning of their own Scriptures. As soon as they turn to the Lord, i.e., as soon as they recognize Jesus Christ as their Jehovah, then everything becomes bright and clear!"

- So Much Of The Old Testament Prophecies:

- Can Now Make Sense To Us:

- When We Look At Them:

- Through The Lense:

- Of Jesus!

- So - With Types:

- You Look Forward To Christ:

- Through The Lenses:

- Of Those Old Testament:

- Images & Illustrations!

- But - With This Kind Of Focus:

- You Are Able To Look Back:

- To The Old Testament:

- Through The Lenses:

- Of The Person & Work Of Christ!

- This Means:

- That There Might Be:

- Even More "Types" Than Those:

- That Are Specifically Given To Us In The New Testament!

- In Many Ways:

- Jesus Christ "Recapitulates":

- What We Find In The Old Testament!

- "Recapitulate" - To Repeat In A Concise Form!

- We Find An Example Of This:

- In Matthew 2:15 - When - After Jesus Came Back From Egypt With His Family:

- Matthew Writes - "That it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, Out of Egypt have I called my son!" - This Is Found In Hosea 11:1! - But - In Hosea - God Is Speaking: - About The Past - "When Israel was a child, then I loved him, and called my son out of Egypt!" - Yet - Matthew Applies This As A Prophecy About The Future! - How Could He Do This? - Because Not Only Is Jesus The "True & Final Israel" - Prince / Son Of God! - But - Because The Life Of Christ, In Many Ways, Mirrors: - The History Of Israel! - Because - After God "Called [His People] Out Of Egypt!" - What Happened? As Dr. Walt Russell Pointed Out: - They Had A "Water Experience!" - In The Red Sea - And Were: - "Baptized Unto Moses" (1 Corinthians 10:2) - And So Did Jesus! - Baptized By John In The Jordan! - They Had A "Wilderness Experience!" - And Tempted The Lord For 40 Years! (Numbers 14:22 / Psalm 95:9) - Well - Jesus Too Had A "Wilderness Experience" When He Was Tempted For 40 Days! Yet Was Faithful! - They Had A "Mountain-Top Experience!" - When God Gave Them His Law At Mt. Sinai! - Jesus Too - Gave His Great Sermon - Where - On A "Mountain!" (Matthew 5:1) - And - Even More: - When Moses Came Down From Mount Sinai: - The "Skin Of His Face Shone" From Talking With God! - But - When Jesus Took "Peter, And James, And John" - "Up Into A High Mountain!" (Mark 9:2) - What Happened? Matthew 17:2 - He "Was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light!" - Not From Without, But From Within! - And - There Are Many More Examples Of This: - When You Look For Them: - Through The Lense Of Christ! - This Is Not "Spiritualizing" The Text - This Is Using Christ & The New Testament For What They Were Intended! - 2 Corinthians 3:16: - The Veil Covering The Old Testament: - "Is Done Away In Christ!" - So - Jesus Is The "Filling Up" Of: - The History Of Israel! - So - In 33 Short Years - Jesus Was Able To Fulfill & Complete All That The Children Of Israel & Even All Of Humanity Couldn't In All Of History! - But That Leads Us To A Sixth And Final Principle Of Prophecy: - And That Is: The Prefiguring Of Prophecy: - And Who Is Now: - The "People Of God!" - As We've Been Learning In Romans: - There Are Two "Israels" In The Bible: - And Really - Three! - Christ - The True Israel! - The National Israel! - And - The Spiritual Israel - Also Known As The Church! - The εκκλησία - The "Called Out" Of God! (Acts 7:38) - So - In Romans 9:6 - Paul Writes - "Not as though the word of God hath taken none effect. For they are

not all Israel, which are of Israel!"

- This Means That:

- Many - And Perhaps Even Most:

- Of God's Promises To Israel:

- In The Old Testament:

- Were Meant For The Spiritual Israel & Not The National Israel!

- So - It Is Important:

- To Think About:

- The Kinds Of Promises & Prophecies:

- That Are Given To "Israel" In The Old Testament!

- Are They:

- Political Promises:

- That Were Meant For: - The Nation Of Israel? Or:

- Are They:

- Spiritual Promises:

- That Were Meant For: - The Spiritual Israel?

- But - In The *True* Israel - Jesus:

- He Came To Fulfull:

- Them All!
